8:27 - It was Jesus's usual way, when he took a walk with his disciples, to spend the time in holy conversation. It would be well if we always did the same. We might do much good, and we might get much good if we made our Lord Jesus the theme of our talks.

8:29 - That is the main point. It matters little what others say about Jesus--whether they are right or wrong--but what is your opinion? "Peter answereth and saith unto him, Thou art the Christ." We know from Matthew's Gospel that Jesus said his Father in heaven had revealed this to Peter.
