2. Not of yourself or of your works

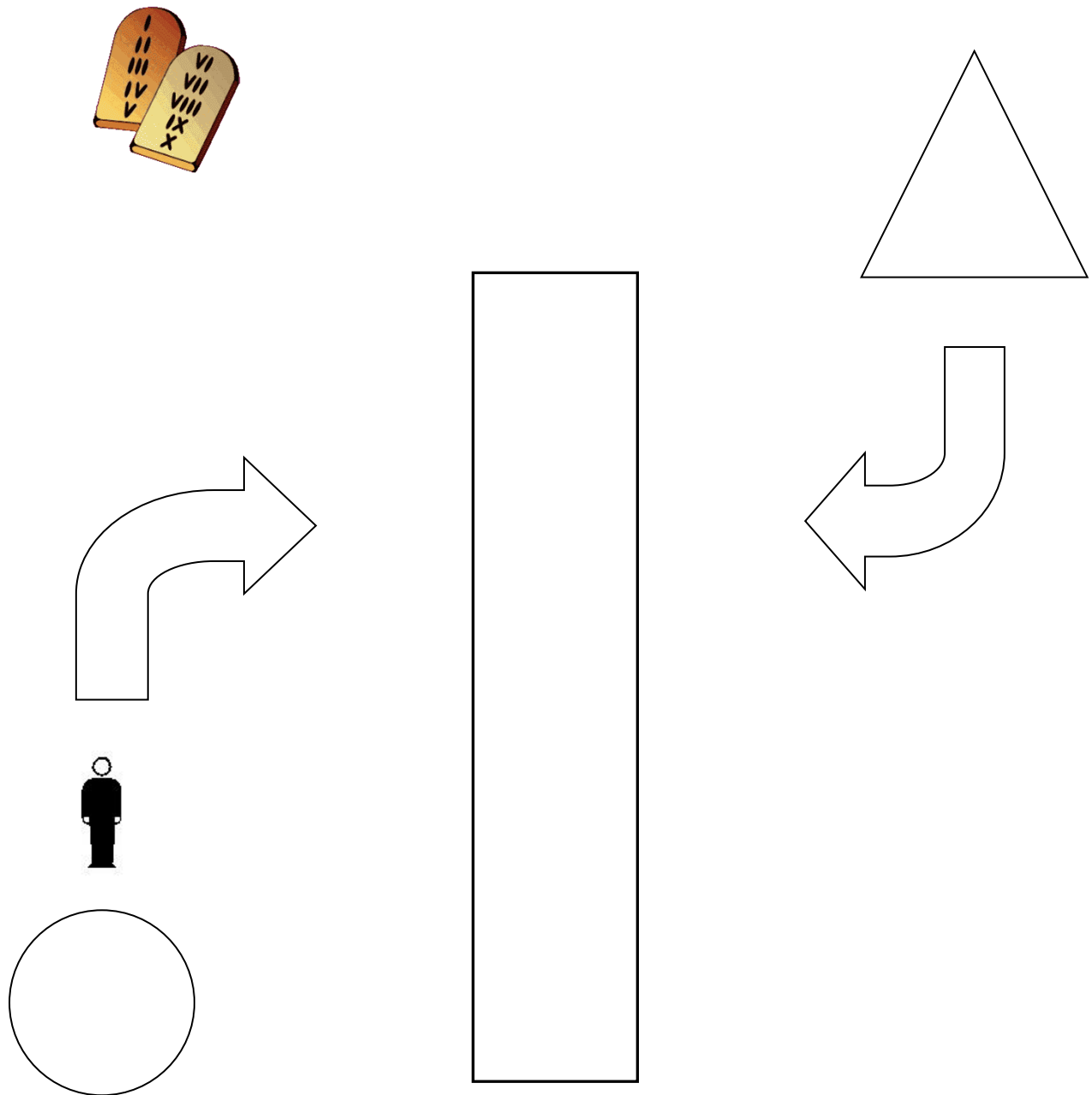
The RESULT of the Gospel

1 John 5:13

2. Assurance of your salvation
