PSALM 38.  
 A Psalm of David, to bring to remembrance.  
 O LORD, rebuke me not in thy wrath: neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure.  
 2 For thine arrows stick fast in me, and thy hand presseth me sore.  
 3 There is no soundness in my flesh because of thine anger; neither is there any rest in my bones because of my sin.  
 4 For mine iniquities are gone over mine head: as an heavy burden they are too heavy for me.  
 5 My wounds stink and are corrupt because of my foolishness.  
 6 I am troubled; I am bowed down greatly; I go mourning all the day long.  
 7 For my loins are filled with a loathsome disease: and there is no soundness in my flesh.  
 8 I am feeble and sore broken: I have roared by reason of the quietness of my heart. - Desperate  
 9 Lord, all my desire is before thee; and my groaning is not hid from thee. - Heart Palpitations  
 10 My heart panteth my strength faileth me: as for the light of mine eyes, it also is gone from me.  
 11 My lovers and my friends stand aloof from my sore; and my kinsmen stand afar off. - Rock Hudson  
 12 They also that seek after my life lay snares for me; and they that seek my hurt speak mischievous things, and imagine deceits all the day long.  
 13 But I, as a deaf man, heard not; and I was as a dumb man that openeth not his mouth.  
 14 Thus I was as a man that heareth not, and in whose mouth are no reproofs. - Isa 53:7 open not mouth  
 15 For in thee, O LORD, do I hope: thou wilt hear, O Lord my God.  
 16 For I said, Hear me, lest otherwise they should rejoice over me: when my foot slippeth, they magnify themselves against me.  
 17 For I am ready to halt, and my sorrow is continually before me.  
 18 For I will declare my iniquity; I will be sorry for my sin.  
 19 But mine enemies are lively, and they are strong: and they that hate me wrongfully are multiplied.

To the chief Musician, even to Jeduthun, A Psalm of David.  
 I SAID, I will take heed to my ways, that I sin not with my tongue: I will keep my mouth with a bridle, while the wicked is before me.  
 2 I was dumb with silence, I held my peace, even from good; and my sorrow was stirred.  
 3 My heart was hot within me, while I was musing the fire burned: then spake I with my tongue.

4 LORD, make me to know mine end, and the measure of my days, what it is; that I may know how frail I am.  
 5 Behold, thou hast made my days as an handbreadth; and mine age is as nothing before thee: verily every man at his best state is altogether vanity. Selah.  
 6 Surely every man walketh in vain shew: surely they are disquieted in vain: he heapeth up riches, and knoweth not who shall gather them. - Ecc 1:21 Vanity vexation

7 And now, LORD, what wait I for? my hope is in thee.  
 8 Deliver me from all my transgressions: make me not the reproach of the foolish.  
 9 I was dumb, I opened not my mouth; because thou didst it. - Job 5:17 Acceptance at Divine Chastisement/Discipline  
 10 Remove thy stroke away from me: I am consumed by the blow of thine hand.  
 11 When thou with rebukes dost correct man for iniquity, thou makest his beauty to consume away like a moth; surely every man is vanity. Selah.

12 Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not thy peace at my tears: for I am a stranger with thee, and a sojourner, as all my fathers were.
