  - 4. A protecting love (Zech 2:8, 12:8-9)
  - 5. an *unreturned love* (Jer 13:11, 3:20)

  - 7. Marriage that lasts to the end of the age (Mt 28:20, Zech 14:9)
  - 8. Marriage that exists now, in Christ (Eph 3:15)

# II. Ephesians 5:28-29: *Imminently Practical*

- A. Loving your wife: A love that is not easy the pain of intimacy
- B. Eph 5:28-29 an immediately useful and understandable command
  - 1. It needs to be easily understood because of the importance of what is being portrayed in marriage
  - 2. God knows the import of this, but so does Satan ...

  - 1. living no longer as "I" but as "we."
  - 2. 1 Cor 7:3-6
  - 3. A single person's life vs. a married person's life (1 Cor 7:32-35)
    - a. How that works out in participation in body life
- D. b. How it works out in setting priorities (God, family, church)

  - 1. We all (single, married, children) are ministered to by marriage

  - 3. Also as a result, how we must value Christian marriage
  - 4. What it means practically to leave and cleave
