1 Thessalonians 5:23-28

I. Paul’s benediction prays for the \_\_\_\_\_  
of the church (5:23).

a. If he is talking to individuals, and even if he is  
addressing the church as a whole, this is a passage  
that would reveal a \_\_\_\_\_ (3-  
parts) paradigm in the composition of man (5:23b,  
“may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept  
blameless”).
