## III. HERO RECRUITMENT, ENLISTMENT AND DEDICATION

- A. A few good men (people) 2 Tim 2:4,5
  - 1. Commitment to the Commander in Chief
  - 2. Commitment to victory over the enemy;
  - 3. Commitment to integrity, loyalty and sacrifice
  - 4. Commitment to endurance of <u>hardships</u>
  - 5. Commitment to being a <u>free slave</u> cut the entanglements, lose the bondage, lose the anxiety, drop the sorrow, stop borrowing trouble: don't make things your problem that are not; don't be guilty for what you did not do; don't play other's agendas
    - 2 Corinthians 10:3-5
  - 6. Commitment to learning the <u>ways</u> of <u>war</u>; <u>wisdom</u> is the principal thing and with it get <u>understanding</u> - Pro 4:7 Ephesians 6:10-20
  - 7. Commitment to a steady use and preparation of your <u>equipment</u>
  - 8. Commitment to your <u>super power!</u> Filled with the Spirit, Word of God, prayer, love
