Romans 12:1

God is calling us to offer our bodies as a sacrifice.

Offering ourselves sacrificially to God is our *reasonable service* - **Psalm 40:6–8**

- A heart willing to love and serve - **Deuteronomy 15:16–17**
- Humility - **Psalm 51:16–17 For You do not desire sacrifice, or else I would give it; You do not delight in burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, A broken and a contrite heart—These, O God, You will not despise.**
- Obedience - **1 Samuel 15:22 So Samuel said: "Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams.**

Christ offered all of Himself to God as a sacrifice for sin - **Hebrews 10:1–10**

- Animal sacrifices are insufficient, inadequate, and cannot take away sin.
- Christ voluntarily entered into human flesh to offer Himself as a sacrifice.
- Because of Christ's complete and full sacrifice of His body, we are in a sanctified position to offer our bodies a sacrifice to serve God.

It will always cost us something to serve the Lord - **1 Chronicles 21:24 Then King David said to Ornan, "No, but I will surely buy it for the full price, for I will not take what is yours for the LORD, nor offer burnt offerings with that which costs me nothing."**

Our reasonable service is our thoughtful, intentional, and loving offering of our body in humility and obedience to the Lord.

Our reasonable service is our worshipping the Lord by giving to Him our life.

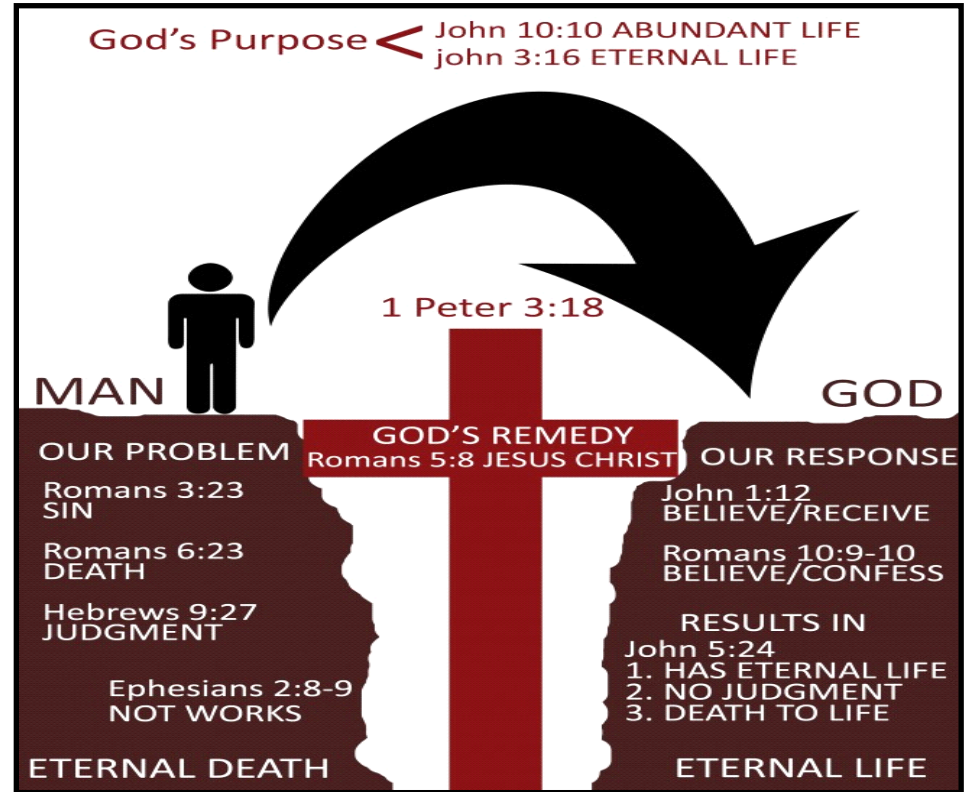
