"Behold, Thy King!" John 12:12-19

Introduction: As We Return In Our Bibles This Morning: 1. - To John 12 - We Come To: - A Great Scene: - In The Final Week Of: - Jesus' Ministry In This World! - It Is The Basis Of: - What We Now Call: - Palm Sunday! - Because - It Is The Triumphal Entry Of Jesus: - Into Jerusalem: - As The Rightful King Of Israel: - And As The King Of Kings, And Lord Of Lords! 2. Now - All Throughout His Ministry: - Jesus Made Clear Statements - And: - Performed Compelling Signs: - To Prove That He Was Indeed: - This King! - And - Over Time: - Many Believed In His Claims! - And - At One Point: - Right After Jesus Miraculously Fed: - The Five Thousand (+) (John 6)! - They Even Tried: - To "Force" Jesus To Be Their King: - Right Then & Right There! 3. But - Even Though Jesus: - Was King - He Wasn't: - The Kind Of King: - They Were Looking For! - Later - In 18:36 - Jesus Will Say To Pontius Pilate: - "My Kingdom Is Not Of This World!" - But - Many, If Not Most, Of His Followers: - Didn't Understand This Yet! - And - This Is What Led To: - The Event We Come To This Morning: - In John 12! Where - Many Jews Had Come: 4. - To The City Of Jerusalem: - To Celebrate The Great Festival Of Passover - As Well As: - The Feast Of Unleavened Bread: - Which Followed For A Week After! - And - During These Festivals: - The Population Of Jerusalem: - Would Swell! - According To Some Jewish Records Of The Time: - Even Though The City Only Had: - About 100,000 Residents During The Year! - That Number Could Grow: - Over 10 Times That: - During These Special Times Of National & Religious Holidays! - To Over 1 Million! And So - As We Read Through: 5. - 12:12-19 - Imagine Crowds: - Not Just Of Hundreds, Or Of Thousands:

- But, Likely, Even Tens Of Thousands:

- Welcoming Jesus To Jerusalem:

- As Their King!

- "On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, / Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord. / And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written, / Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt. / These things understood not his disciples at the first: but when Jesus was glorified, then remembered they that these things were written of him, and that they had done these things unto him. / The people therefore that was with him when he called Lazarus out of his grave, and raised him from the dead, bare record. / For this cause the people also met him, for that they heard that he had done this miracle. / The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him!"

- After Just Three Years Of Public Ministry:

- Thousands Upon Thousands:

- Either Saw Jesus:

- With Their Own Eyes!

- Or Heard About Jesus:

- With Their Own Ears!

- And - Having Been Under The Power:

- Of The Roman Empire Now - For:

- Almost 100 Years - Many Of The Jews:

- Were Longing:

- To Be Free & Independent:

- Once Again!

- And - Who Better:

- To Lead Them:

- Than Someone Who Could:

- Heal The Sick - And:

- Even Raise The Dead!

- And - All This Brings About:

- The Climax We Just Read About:

- There In 12:12-13 - Which Tells Us About:

1. The Reception Of Jesus:

- At His Coming To Jerusalem!

- His Reception - Even As King!

- So - When Many Of Those:

- Who Came To Jerusalem:

- To Celebrate The Passover:

- "Heard That Jesus Was Coming To Jerusalem!"

- What Did They Do?

- According To 12:13:

- They First - Put Their Hope In Jesus:

- As Their King!

- This Is Why They:

- "Took Branches Of Palm Trees, And Went Forth To Meet Him!"

- Now - Palm Trees - During This Time:

- Were Plentiful In Jerusalem!

- As They Still Are - Because Of The:

- Climate Of The Region!

- And - The Trees & Their Leaves:

- Were Used As Symbols:

- In Religious Celebrations Of The Jews!

- Early On - In Leviticus 23:40:

- For The Feast Of Tabernacles:

- The Jews Were Supposed To Take: "Branches Of Palm Trees" And "Rejoice Before The Lord (Their) God!"

- But - Over Time - Palm Branches: - Became A Symbol Of: - Of The Nation & Race Of The Jews: - As Well! - And - During Times Of: - National & Political Demonstrations: - The People Would Cut & Wave The Branches: - Just Like We Wave The Flag On The Fourth OF July! - In Fact - Just Before The Destruction Of Jerusalem: - By Rome - In AD70 - The Jewish Resistance Minted Coins With: - Palm Branches On Them! - And So - After Hearing So Much About Jesus: - And His Powerful, Wonderful Works: - Thousands & Thousands Of Faithful Jews Rallied To Meet Jesus: - When They Heard That He Was Making His Way To Jerusalem! - And - They Were Ready To Welcome & Receive Jesus - Being Filled With: - National Pride & Zeal & Hope! - Taking & Waving Their Flags Of Palm Branches As They Went! - And So - Then - Also According To 12:13: - They Gave Their Honor To Jesus: - As Their King! - Because - When They Finally Met Jesus: - On The Path To Jerusalem: - They "Cried, Hosanna! Blessed Is The King Of Israel That Cometh In The Name Of The Lord!" - Now - Even Though - There Is More Detail: - About Jesus' Triumphal Entry: - In The Parallel Passages Of Matthew & Mark & Luke! - We Are Going To Focus Primarily On: - What John Gives Us, In More Or Less, A Summary Form! - But - By Singing & Shouting These Words: - That Come Directly From: - Psalm 118 - Which Is Last Of The Great Hallel Psalms - Sung By The Jews: - During Their Festivals & Celebrations! - They Honored Jesus As: - The One Who God Promised: - To Send - "In The Name Of The Lord" - And "Destroy" Those Who Came Against Them! (118:10-12) - They Honored Jesus - By Recognizing: - His Ability - To Save! - Because - "Hosanna" - Means: - "Save, Now!" - And - The Jews Saw In Jesus: - The One Who Could Save Them! - But - What Kind Of "Salvation" Were They Looking For? - They Also Honored Jesus - By Recognizing: - His Approval - By God! - They Knew That, In Order To Succeed: - Their Savior & Deliverer Would Have To Have The Favor & Blessing Of God Upon Him! - And The People Were Convinced That: - Jesus Was The One! - So They Cried - "Blessed Is (The One) That Cometh In The Name Of The Lord!" - They Further Honored Jesus - By Recognizing: - His Authority - As King! - When Jesus Was In Galilee - Many Wanted To - "Take Him By Force, To Make Him A

King!" (6:15) - And Now - It Seemed Like: - Jesus Was Finally "Coming Around" To Their Point Of View! - And So - They Called Him: - "The King Of Israel!" - Even - Their King! - What A Reception This Was - On That Day! - What A Welcome For Jesus! - And - Of Course - All That They Said: - About Jesus - Was Right & True! - Jesus Did Have: - The Ability - To Save Them! - Jesus Did Have: - The Approval - Of God Upon Him! And: - Jesus Did Possess: - The Authority - As King! - And - Jesus Accepted: - All Of Their Honor & Praise! - When Some Of The Pharisees: - Told Jesus To - "Rebuke Thy Disciples!" - According To The Gospel Of Luke: - Jesus Said: - "If These Should Hold Their Peace, The Stones Would Immediately Cry Out!" (Luke 19:39-40) - But - Just As The People's Pride & Praise: - Was Reaching Its Height: - We See A Sudden Turn Of Events! - A Turn Of Events: - That Would Reveal To Them & To Us: The Reason For Jesus: - Coming To Jerusalem As King! Because: - In 12:14-15 - Jesus Revealed: - The Truth About His Coming! - "And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written, / Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt!" - Through His Own Actions: - Jesus Revealed The True Reason: - For His Coming - Not Just Into Jerusalem That Day: - But Into The World! - And - Jesus Revealed His Reason: - For Coming: - In What He Found! - There In 12:14: - "And Jesus, When He Had Found A Young Ass, Sat Thereon!" - Now - There Is More Detail About: - How Jesus Sent Two Of His Disciples: - To Find & Retrieve Both A Donkey & Her Foal! - But - The Significance Is In: - What Jesus Used: - To Ride Into Jerusalem! - It Was A Donkey! - Not A Horse! - A Horse - Was An Animal: - Fit For A King! - A Donkey - Was An Animal: - Used By A Servant! - A Horse - Was A Symbol Of:

- Majesty & Might! - A Donkey - Was A Symbol Of: - Meekness & Humility! - A Horse - Was Used: - To Bring Deliverance: - Through Power! - A Donkey - Was Often Used: - To Bring Dispatches: - Of Peace! - And - When Jesus Rode Into Jerusalem That Day: - The People Would Have Expected Jesus: - To Come On A Horse! - But Instead - Jesus Rode In: - On Donkey! - Would The People: - Still Receive & Welcome Him: - According To His Terms & His Reason, Rather Than Their Own? - Time Would Tell! - But Then - John Adds How: - Jesus Revealed His Reason: - For Coming: - In What He Fulfilled! - Even The Prophecy Found In: - Zechariah 9:9 - Which John Summarizes For Us: - In 12:15 - "Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt!" - It Is This Verse In Zechariah - Along With: - The Verses Around It: - That Reveals The True Reason: - For Jesus Coming & First Advent Into This World! - Though - Jesus Did Come: - In Greatness: - As Their "King!" - Which They Themselves Recognized! - Jesus Also Came: - In Gentleness: - "Sitting On An Ass's Colt!" - Which Not Even Jesus' Disciples Understood Yet! - But - It Would Take Both: - The Greatness & The Gentleness: - Of Jesus - That Is: - Both His Majesty & His Meekness! - As Both King & Servant! - That Would Bring About: - His People's Highest Good! So That: - They Could Experience Real Joy Instead Of Fear! - This Was The Real Reason: - For Jesus' Coming: - To Jerusalem & To This World! - But, Sadly, Most Of Them: - Wanted Jesus To Come: - On Their Terms: - Instead Of His! - And - It Seems Like: - For Awhile - This Was True: - Even For His Own Disciples! - And So - In 12:16: - We Can See How Jesus Revealed:

- The Reason For His Coming: - In What He Furnished! - Which Was - Illumination & Insight! - Because Then - In 12:16 - John Explains: - "These things understood not his disciples at the first: but when Jesus was glorified, then remembered they that these things were written of him, and that they had done these things unto him!" - So - After Jesus Was Fully "Glorified!" - Through His Death, Resurrection, & Ascension: - Being Raised Up Higher & Higher: - To His Heavenly Home & Throne! - John Tells Us That: - The Disciples "Remembered" Both: - The Prophecy: - Of God's Plan! - As Well As: - Their Participation: - In God's Plan! - But - How Did They Come: - To "Remember" These Things? - By The Spirit Of God! - In Just A Couple Of More Days: - Jesus Himself Would Tell His Disciples In The Upper Room: - 14:26 - That The Holy Spirit Would "Bring All Things To (Their) Remembrance!" - And So - Through What Jesus: - Found On The Street: - Fulfilled From The Scripture: - And Furnished Through The Spirit! - Jesus Revealed: - The True Reason: - For His Coming! - Jesus Came: - Not To Save & Deliver: - His People From Their: - National & Political Subjugation: - To Rome! - Jesus Came: - To Save & Deliver: - His People From Their: - Sin! - Even As Jesus Said In: - Mark 10:45 - "For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many!" - But - This Is Not: - The Kind Of Savior: - The People Were Looking For! - They Were Looking For: - Jesus To Come To Them: - As A Lion! - But Instead - Jesus Came To Them: - As A Lamb! Even As: - "The Lamb Of God, Which Taketh Away The Sin Of The World!" (1:29) - And Yet - Jesus Is Both! - Even In Revelation 5:5-6 - When John: - Is Taken To Heaven In A Vision - He Is Told By One Of The Elders There To: - "Behold, The Lion Of The Tribe Of Judah!" - And Then - John Tells Us:

- "And I Beheld, And, Lo, In The Midst Of The Throne . . . Stood A Lamb As It Had Been Slain!" - So - John Heard About A Lion - But: - He Saw A Lamb! - Because Jesus Is Both! - And - The Problem For The Jews: - In Jesus Day - Is That They Were Not Willing: - To Receive Jesus: - The Way He Chose To Reveal Himself To Them! - They Wanted Jesus: - To Come As Their King! - And As A Mighty Lion! - And, Even Though Jesus Was / Is King: - He Chose To Come First As A Servant! - And As A Meek Lamb! - But - It Seems Like Today: - We Have The Opposite Problem! - The World & Many In The Church: - Only Want To Receive Jesus: - In His Character: - As A Lamb! Meek & Humble & Gentle! - And Yet - We Forget That: - The Way Jesus Is Revealed To Us: - Is The Way Jesus Is To Be Received By Us! - Again: - The Way Jesus Is Revealed To Us: - Is The Way Jesus Is To Be Received By Us! - And Jesus Is Revealed To Us: - As Both A Lamb & A Lion! - Yes - Jesus Is Meek! - But He Is Also Majestic & Mighty! - The King Of Kings - And: - The Lord Of Lords! - Jesus Served & Serves Us: - So That We Might: - Serve Him! - And - Yes - Jesus Is Humble! - But He Is Also Holy! - And When He Came To Save Us: - From The Penalty Of Sin! - He Also Came To Sanctify Us: - From The Power Of Sin: - Over Us! - So That We Might Have: - Forgiveness & Freedom: - Not - To Sin - But: - From Sin! - And - Yes - Jesus Is Gentle! - But He Is Also Great & Glorious! - And The Way Jesus Is Revealed To You: - Is The Way Jesus Is To Be Received By You! - And - When This Is The Case: - For You - Only Then You Can Experience: The Reaction To Jesus:

- And His Coming As King! - That We Find Next In 12:17-18:

- "The people therefore that was with him when he called Lazarus out of his grave, and raised him

from the dead, bare record. / For this cause the people also met him, for that they heard that he had done this miracle!" - There Are 2 Groups Of People: - In These 2 Verses! - The First Group - Was A Smaller Group: - That Was Made Up Of The People Who: - Went With Jesus - From Bethany: - To Jerusalem! - And - They Are The Ones Who: - Heard Jesus' Powerful Word - And: - Saw Jesus' Powerful Work: - When It Came To Raising Lazarus From The Dead! (Chapter 11) - And From Back In 11:45: - It Seems Like They Really Did: - Believe In Him! - Even In A Saving Way! - And So - As Jesus Was Finally: - Making His Way To Jerusalem: - They Just Couldn't Help Themselves! - They Kept On Telling People: - About What Jesus Had Done! - And So: - The People - Of The Second & Larger Group: - Were Excited - As Well! - According To 12:18 - This Was One Of The Reasons Why They Went Out To Meet Jesus! - They Responded To: - The Testimony Of Jesus' Followers About: - His Miracle! - A Miracle Which Was: - Just Another "Sign" - That: - Confirmed Jesus' Claims! - And - Though They Didn't Fully Understand It All: - They Rightly Concluded: - As Others Had In 7:31 - "When Christ cometh, will he do more miracles than these which this man hath done?" - Only When You: - Receive Jesus - In The Way: - He Is Fully Revealed To You: - Can You Then React To Him: - In The Right Way! - Only Then Can You: - Be Struck By His Wonder: - And Be More Of His Witness! - But - As Much Excitement & Enthusiasm: - As There Was About Jesus: - On That Day! - In 12:19 - We Also See That: - The Pharisees Were Enraged! - Even More! - Because - "The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him!" - They Were Enraged: - Because Of Their: - Powerlessness! - And - They Were Enraged: - Because Of His: - Popularity! - And - Once Again:

- As We've Seen Throughout John's Gospel:

- There Are Two Kinds Of Reactions:

- When People Are Confronted With:

- The Claims Of Jesus!

- Some - Will Receive Him:

- At Least, In Some Measure!

- While Others:

- Will Continue To Resist Him!

- But - The Work Of Jesus:

- Will Continue!

- And Though - What The Pharisees Said:

- Might Have Been An Exaggeration Made Out Of Exasperation!
- "Behold, The World Is Gone After Him!"

- This Was More True Than:

- The Knew!

- Because - What Do We Find Next:

- In 12:20? "And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast!"

Conclusion:

1. And So - The Ministry Of Jesus:

- As Both Lion & Lamb:

- Was Intended To Reach:

- The Entire World!

- And - In One Sense:

- It Already Has!

- Even - To Where We Are This Very Morning! (6,215 Miles Away!)

- Because - This Too:

- Is In Fulfilment Of:

- The Prophecy Found In Zechariah 9 - Where:

- In 9:9-10 - The Same King Who "Is Just, And Having Salvation; Lowly, And Riding Upon An Ass, And Upon A Colt The Foal Of An Ass!"

- He Is The One Who "Shall Speak Peace Unto The Heathen: And His Dominion Shall Be From Sea Even To Sea, And From The River Even To The Ends Of The Earth!"

2. We Are Those Who Live:

- In "The Ends Of The Earth!"

- And Now - We Can Behold Jesus:

- As Our King!

- But - We Must Never Forget That:

- The Way Jesus Is Revealed To Us:

- Is The Way Jesus Is To Be Received By Us!

- We Must Not Receive Jesus:

- On Our Terms - But On His!

- Because - Only When We Believe In:

- And Welcome Jesus:

- In Both His Mercy & His Majesty:

- Only Then Can We React To & Live For:

- Jesus In The Right Way!

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
