## "In The Flesh" Romans 8:5-8

## Introduction:

- 1. Let's Open Our Bibles:
  - Tonight To Romans 8:
    - As We Continue Looking At:
      - The Enemy Of Our Flesh!
  - The Flesh:
    - Is The Second Spiritual Enemy:
      - That We Need To Fight Against:
        - Even As The Old English Puritan Prayer Reminds Us:
          - "From All Deceits Of The World, The Flesh, And The Devil, Good Lord,
          - Deliver Us!"
    - And We Need To Keep Praying This Way:
      - Because Of What:
        - Our "Flesh" Has Become!
- 2. Of Course At First:
  - "The Flesh" Was Nothing But:
    - A Positive Thing To Us!
      - Because It Was Designed For Our Good:
        - So That We Might Experience The Spiritual Goodness Of God:
          - In Physical Ways!
  - And There Are Many Times:
    - In Both The Old & New Testaments:
      - That "Flesh" Is Used In This:
        - Normal & Natural Sense!
          - And Refers To Just Our Basic Human Nature:
            - The Way God Designed Us To Be!
- 4. But When Adam & Eve Rebelled Against:
  - The Authority Of God In The Garden Of Eden:
    - And Sinned Against Him:
      - That Was The Demise & Death Of:
        - The Goodness Of Our Flesh!
  - And From Then Until Now:
    - "The Flesh" Has Taken On:
      - A Negative Meaning!
    - Because It Goes Far Deeper Than:
      - The Skin And Is Totally Depraved!
  - Which Means That:
    - Every Person Is Born:
      - Totally Corrupt:
        - From Head To Toe And:
          - From The Inside Out!
  - So Sin Infects:
    - Every Part Of Our Human Nature!
      - Sin Infects:
        - Our Minds!
        - Our Hearts!
        - Our Wills!
        - And Even Our Consciences!
  - And This Fallen Nature:
    - Which Is In Each One Of Us:
      - Is "The Flesh" That Has Now Become:
        - One Of Our Greatest Spiritual Enemies!
          - Because It Is The:
            - Enemy Within Us!
    - The Enemies Of:

- The World & The Devil:
  - May Try To Defeat Us:
    - From The Outside!
- But They Have An Ally:
  - On The Inside:
    - Which Is Our Own Flesh!
- One Description Of "The Flesh" That:
  - I Came Across This Week:
    - May Help Us Understand More:
      - About What It Is & What It Does!
  - John Piper:
    - Former Pastor Of Bethlehem Baptist Church, Minneapolis, Minnesota:
      - "The Flesh Is The 'I' Who Tries To Satisfy 'Me' With Anything But God & His Mercy!"
- 5. And We Can See This In:
  - What The Apostle Paul Writes:
    - In Romans 8:5-8:
      - "For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. / For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. / Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. / So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God!"
  - So The Phrases That Paul Uses:
    - In These Verses Like:
      - "After The Flesh!" (8:5)
      - "Carnally Minded!" (8:6)
      - And "In The Flesh!" (8:8)
        - Are Equivalent To A Person:
          - Being Without Christ!
        - Even Unbelievers:
          - Who "Cannot Please God!"
  - And So From 8:5 We Can See:
- 1. The Disposition Of The Flesh!
  - A Disposition Is What A Person Is Inclined To Do:
    - Based On Who They Are!
      - **IE:** A Good Example Of This Is The "Tastes" Different People Have In Food! You May Like Something That Somebody Else Does Not Like!
        - And Yet Neither Of You Can Understand How The Other Person Could Possibly Like It! Like Tomato Soup!
      - For One Reason Or Another:
        - People Have Different Dispositions & Inclinations Based On:
          - Who They Are! Their Past / Their Tastes / Their Experiences!
    - And In This Verse:
      - We Find Mentioned First:
  - The Disposition Of Unbelievers!
    - As Paul Writes:
      - 8:5a "For They That Are After The Flesh Do Mind The Things Of The Flesh!"
        - Again When Paul Talks About The "Flesh" Here He Is Not Just Talking About The Physical You!
          - He's Referring To The Fallen You! The Sinful You!
  - And As We Saw Last Sunday This Fallen Nature:
    - Has Infected Every Part Of You!
      - Your Human Nature:
        - Is Depraved And Has Been:
          - Completely Stained By The Principle Of Sin!
    - And So Without Christ:
      - You Will Be Constantly Swayed By Sin:
        - Because You Are Still In The Service Of Sin!

- Now How Can You Tell:
  - If This Is Still Your Life?
    - Because You Still:
      - "Mind The Things Of The Flesh!"
  - To "Mind" Here:
    - Means Your Disposition:
      - Is Toward The "Things Of The Flesh!"
  - It Means That:
    - There Is A Special Focus:
      - On Those Things:
        - With Your Mind!
  - It Means That:
    - There Is A Certain Fondness:
      - On Those Things:
        - In Your Heart!
  - And It Also Means That:
    - There Is A Deep Favor:
      - On Those Things:
        - In Your Will!
- **IE:** Those Who "Walk After The Flesh" Will Always Gravitate Toward "The Things Of The Flesh!" And What Are Those "Things Of The Flesh?
  - In Galatians 5 They Are Defined For Us:
    - 5:19-21 "Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, / Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, / Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God!"
  - Now This Does Not Mean That:
    - If You Walk "After The Flesh" That:
      - You Will Pursue Every Single One Of These Sins!
    - Nor Does It Mean That:
      - You Will Go To The Extreme Depths Of A Sin Either!
  - But It Does Mean That:
    - You Have An Affinity:
      - Toward Sin!
    - You Are Bent Toward:
      - Pleasing Yourself:
        - In Some Or In All Of The Ways Mentioned Here!
  - Your Desire Is To Fulfill Your Own Lusts:
    - For Personal Pleasure, Or Prominence, Or Power, Or Passion:
      - Outside Of God's Will And Contrary To God's Word!
- And This Would Still Be Our Life:
  - If We Were Still Walking "After The Flesh!"
    - But Then From 8:6 We Can See:
- 2. The Direction Of The Flesh!
  - "For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace!"
    - There Are Two Different Destinations:
      - Referred To In This Verse!
        - **IE:** And This Is A Good Reminder That The Way Of The World & The Way Of The Lord Are Not Parallel Tracks That Lead To The Same Destination! No They Are Opposite! And So Paul First Points Out:
  - The Direction Of The Flesh:
    - In 8:6a "For to be carnally minded is death!"
      - "Carnally Minded" Can Also Be Translated:
        - The "Mind Of The Flesh!"
      - It Refers To That Disposition:
        - And That "State Of Mind And Heart" That Gravitates Toward:

- "The Things Of The Flesh!"
  - This Is Your Main Outlook On Life!
- And Where Does This Kind Of Mind:
  - Lead? Where Does It Always End Up?
    - What Is Its Direction?
      - "Death!" And Death Is At Its Core:
        - Separation!
  - When You Talk About:
    - Physical Death:
      - It Is Because A Person Has Been Separated From Their Body!
  - But When You Talk About:
    - Spiritual Death:
      - It Is Because A Person Is Separated From God Forever!
- We Need To Realize:
  - That The Mind Of The Flesh As Well As:
    - The Works Of The Flesh:
      - Are Dangerous And Deadly!
  - And Yet How Often:
    - Do People Still Run After Sin:
      - With All Of Their Heart!
- And This Would Still Be Our Life:
  - If We Were Still Walking "After The Flesh!"
    - But What A Terrible Way To Live:
      - Knowing That All You Have To Look Forward To:
        - Is Death!
  - But Then From 8:7 We Can See:

## 3. The Determination Of The Flesh!

- 8:7 "Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be!"
  - Those Who Possess The "Mind Of The Flesh" Rarely Think:
    - That Who They Are Or What They Are Doing:
      - Are Dangerous And Deadly!
        - And So We Need To See Our Fallen Nature:
          - For What It Really Is!
  - Sinners Are Determined:
    - In Their Rebellion Against God:
      - And His Law!
        - In This Verse We See That:
- The Flesh Is Hostile:
  - Toward God!
    - 8:7a "Because The Carnal Mind The Mind Of The Flesh Is Enmity Against God!"
      - Note The Word Here Is:
        - "Enmity" Not Just "Enemy!"
    - **IE:** Probably Heard The Names "The Hatfields & The McCoys" Notorious For A Family Feud That Went On In The South For Generations Lives Were Lost In That Feud After A While
    - Forgot Why They Were Fighting! They Remained Enemies And The Enmity Was In Who They Were Even In Their Names!
      - So It Is With Our Sin And Flesh!
  - Its Not Just What The Flesh Does:
    - That Makes It God's Enemy!
      - Its What It Is!
    - Its Not Just What Takes Place On The Outside:
      - Its What Goes On On The Inside!
    - The Flesh Is Actively Hostile:
      - Toward God! But Also:
- The Flesh Is Hateful:
  - Toward God And His Law!

- 8:7b "For It Is Not Subject To The Law Of God!"
  - Back In Romans 7:12 We Are Told That:
    - "The law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good!"
- But The "Mind Of The Flesh" Is:
  - Neither Holy, Nor Just, Nor Good!
    - And The Way Someone Reacts To:
      - God's Law & His Word:
        - Reveals What They Think About God Himself!
- Does The Law Of God:
  - Stir You Up? Does The Word Of God:
    - Move You And Soften You?
      - Or Does It Lead To Even More:
        - Resistance To God's Commands, God's Control, And God's Constraints Over You?
  - The Flesh Is Actively Hateful:
    - Toward God And His Law! But Even More:
- The Flesh Is Headstrong:
  - Against God!
    - 8:7c "Neither indeed can be!"
  - This Describes How:
    - Completely Corrupt And Depraved The Flesh Is!
      - It Is Like The Tongue Described In James:
        - James 3:7-8 "For every kind of beasts, and of birds, and of serpents, and of things in the sea, is tamed, and hath been tamed of mankind: But the tongue can no man tame!"
  - Some Things Just Can't Be Tamed!
    - This Is What The Flesh:
      - Our Fallen Human Nature:
        - Is Like!
    - I Can't Tame Or Control:
      - My Flesh! And:
        - Neither Can You!
          - Only God Can!

- And This Is Why:
  - Our Flesh Is Destined For Death!
    - It Is Because Apart From God's Intervention:
      - Our Flesh Is Determined To Persist:
        - In Our Hostility And Hatefulness Against God!
          - And There's Nothing You Nor I Can Do About It In Or By Ourselves!
  - And Sadly This Would Still Be Our Life:
    - Apart From God's Mercy!
      - But Then From 8:8 We Can See:
- 4. The Dwelling Of The Flesh:
  - 8:8 "So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God!"
    - To Be "In The Flesh" Here:
      - Means That:
        - You Are Living Your Life:
          - "Under The Government" Of Something Or Someone!
    - And So To Be "In The Flesh" Means:
      - That You Are Living Under:
        - The Government Of Sin!
  - And So Your Basic Instincts & Inclinations:
    - As A Sinner:
      - Are To Sin!
        - And Sin Never Pleases God!
    - And Apart From The Intervention Of God:

- This Will Always Be The Case!
  - In Jeremiah 13:23 The Lord Asks This Penetrating Question "Can the Ethiopian change his skin, or the leopard his spots? then may ye also do good, that are accustomed to do evil!"

## **Conclusion:**

- 1. So What Can Be Done:
  - With Our Flesh?
    - Here In Romans 8 The Apostle Paul:
      - Was "Persuaded Of Better Things" For:
        - The Christians He Was Writing To:
          - There In The City Of Rome!
- 2. And We Can Be "Persuaded Of Better Things" As Well:
  - Because If There Is Within You:
    - A Desire To:
      - "Please God" It Means Something!
    - After All This Is:
      - "The True Goal Of The Believer's Life!" (Hendrickson)
  - Do You Have This Desire?
    - To Please God Means:
      - "To Fill God's Heart With Delight!" (Hendrickson)
        - Is This How You Want To Live Your Life?
- 3. If So Then It Means That You Are Now:
  - In The Spirit!
    - 8:9a "But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you!"
      - You Are Living Under The Government:
        - Of A New Master Jesus Christ And:
          - Under The Guidance:
            - Of The Holy Spirit Whom He Sent!
- 4. What Encouraging Words:
  - These Must Have Been:
    - To That Roman Church:
      - Who Were Living In Such:
        - A Culture Of The Flesh!
          - Weak!
          - Worldly!
          - Wicked!
- 5. Because Now They And We If We Are Believers In Christ:
  - Have Such A Connection With:
    - The Holy Spirit That:
      - He Changes Us!
  - But What Makes This Change Possible?
    - If I Can't Change My Own Flesh:
      - How Can It Be Changed?
- 6. Because 8:9 "If So Be That The Spirit Of God Dwell In You!"
  - This Is The Key!
    - In John 14:16-17 Jesus Said "And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; / Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you!"
  - When You Believe On The Lord Jesus Christ:
    - He Sends The Holy Spirit:
      - To Make Your Heart:
        - His Home And Will:
          - Renew It And Sanctify It So That:
            - You Will No Longer Be "In The Flesh!"
              - Even Though Your Flesh May Still Be In You!

- 7. And Now The Spirit Of God:
  - Will Change You & Give You:

- A New Disposition!
  - 8:5 So That "They that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit!"
- He Will Change You & Give You:
  - A New Direction!
    - Because ""To be spiritually minded is life and peace!"
- And He Will Change You & Give You:
  - A New Desire!
    - To Please God!
    - And He Has Changed:
      - Our Destiny! (8:6)
- 8. Because When You Turn To & Trust In Jesus Alone:
  - For Salvation From Your Sin:
    - Then There Is A Great Change That Takes Place:
      - Through The Work Of The Holy Spirit Of God!
        - He Changes You & Gives You:
          - A New Disposition:
            - Toward "The Things Of The Spirit!"
        - He Changes You & Gives You:
          - A New Direction & Destination:
            - Of Life & Peace Through Jesus Christ!
        - He Changes You & Gives You:
          - A New Desire:
            - To Please God!
- 9. It Is Only Through The Spirit Of God:
  - That We Can Have Ongoing Victory:
    - Over The Enemy Of:
      - The Flesh!

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
