Responsive Reading

Leader: Which is the first commandment?

People: The first commandment is, Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

Leader: What is required in the first commandment?

People: The first commandment requires us to know and acknowledge God to be the only true God, and our God; and to worship and glorify him accordingly.

Leader: What is forbidden in the first commandment?

People: The first commandment forbids the denying, or not worshipping and glorifying, the true God as God, and our God; and the giving of that worship and glory to any other, which is due to him alone. (Shorter Catechism 45-47)

Corporate Confession of Sin

Leader: Almighty God and merciful Father, we confess that we were born in sin; we confess that like wayward sheep we have gone astray and followed after our own way.

People: We confess that we have not believed in you, our one God and Father, but have put our faith in and worshiped other people and things, instead of you alone.

All: Have mercy on us, and turn our hearts to you and forgive our sins through your Son Jesus Christ.
