Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of the sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of the study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

1. Read **Matthew 6:12; 1 John 1:8-9** and **Psalm 86:5.** Describe how ignoring your sin (instead of quickly and regularly repenting and confessing it) impacts your Christian life. How does God's readiness to forgive the penitent help you prioritize prayer? How will you work to keep this in mind?

- 2. Read **Colossians 1:12-14; 1 Timothy 4:4-5** and **1 Timothy 6:17-19.** What do you learn from these passages about the way you can and should be more thankful?
- 3. Read **Ephesians 6:10-20.** How does so much of our spiritual battle relate to our evangelism? What specific challenges are added to your life when you take seriously your job as an ambassador of Christ and the gospel?
- 4. Read **1 Corinthians 15:33** and **Ephesians 5:5-16.** What practical counsel and cautions would you give someone who is attempting to build relationships and bridges with those who need the gospel?

5. Read **1** Thessalonians 1:6-10 and **1** Peter 3:13-17. Give some practical examples of having to "give an answer" to the people of our day regarding the gospel and the truth about Christ. What types of answers do Christians need to have as we engage our generation with the call to turn from the idols of our day and be saved from the coming wrath of God?
