1 John 2:3-17

I. Knowing God is Tested by Obeying God 2:3-11

- A. How to Know that we Know Him 2:3
- B. The Liar 2:4
- C. God's Love Perfected 2:5-6

John uses this Greek phrase "the love of God" in 3 ways in this epistle.

- 1. God's love for us as believers.
- 2. The believers love for God.
- 3. The love that comes from God that causes us to love one another.
- "Keeps" is present tense = continuous.
- 1. This is how we know we are "in Him".
- 2. So we are to walk as He (Jesus) walked.
- **1 Peter 2:21** -- For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you might follow in his steps. (ESV)
- **1 Thess. 2:10-12** -- ¹⁰ You *are* witnesses, and God *also*, how devoutly and justly and blamelessly we behaved ourselves among you who believe; ¹¹ as you know how we exhorted, and comforted, and charged every one of you, as a father *does* his own children, ¹² that you would walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.

D. An Old Commandment and a New Commandment 2:7-8

Much confusion has been raised by this statement. It certainly is not a contradiction – it is a contrast.

Here is the New Commandment. **2 John 4-6** – It is love and it is proven by obedience

John 13:34-35 – John is referencing back to the words of Christ

II. Three Stages of Christian Life in the Church 2:12-14

- A. What is true about the little Children?
 - 1. Their sins are forgiven!
 - 2. They know God the Father through Jesus Christ the Lord!
- B. What is true about the young strong Men (and women)?
 - 1. Their sins are forgiven and they know God the Father through the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - 2. They battle with the Evil One and overcome!
 - 3. They have learned they have grown they have overcome!
- C. What is true about the older Saints (Fathers)?

They have known Him who is from the beginning.
