# "How Can I Fear?" Revelation 1:17-20

#### **Introduction:**

- 1. Do You Have A Phobia?
  - Even If You Don't Think You Have One, You Probably Do, According To Most Psychology Reference Books!
  - "The Phobia List" Is A Resource That Has Tried To Compile A Complete List Of Actual Phobias "Found In A Reference Book Or Medical Paper!" (www.phobialist.com)
    - Come Up With 530 So Far Here Are A Few:
      - Motorphobia Fear Of Automobiles
      - Ballistophobia Fear Of Bullets
      - Ecclesiophobia Fear Of Church
      - Pediophobia Fear Of Dolls
      - Octopphobia Fear Of The Number 8
- 2. Of Course, Christians Have Phobias Also!
  - Even Spiritual Phobias!
    - Especially In "Spiritually Harsh Environments!"
    - Some Are More Legitimate Than Others!
    - Fear Of Trials! Temptations! Tribulation!
  - Whatever Phobia / Fear You Have The Strong Christian & The Strong Church Looks To Jesus!
    - Who Says: "Fear Not!"
    - When Jesus Called Peter, James & John, They Were Afraid When Jesus Miraculously Provided Them A Huge Catch Of Fish, Jesus Said: "Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men!" (Luke 5:10)
    - When Jairus' Daughter Was Dead, Jesus Said: "Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole!" (Luke 8:50)
    - And When John Saw The Vision Of Jesus In All His Glory, And "Fell at his feet as dead" Jesus "Laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not!" (Revelation 1:17)
- 3. John Was Afraid! What Name Would They Come Up With For His Phobia?
  - But Look What Jesus Did!
    - John Felt His Tender Touch!
      - "Laid His Right Hand Upon Me!"
      - Previously, John Had Seen 7 Stars Held In This Right Hand, Symbolizing His Great Power! Now, The Hand Of Control Became The Hand Of Concern & Care For John!
      - What Happened To The 7 Stars?
        - It Never Says They Were Moved! They Probably Remained In Jesus' Hand But Now, John Was Included With Them!
      - Only Jesus' Hand Could Calm John's Fear!
    - John Heard His Tender Voice!
      - "Fear Not!"
      - Stop Being Afraid! Because Of John's Relationship With Jesus, He Did Not Need To Fear!
      - Only Jesus' Voice Could Calm John's Fear!
- 4. And The Lord Jesus Can Calm Your Fear Also!
  - How?

## 1. Through His Great Identity!

- 1:17-18 "I am the first and the last: / I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death!"
  - One Of The Main Reasons For Fear Is Uncertainty!
    - Uncertainty About Life!
    - Uncertainty About Death!
    - Uncertainty About What Happens After Death!
  - John & His Churches May Have Been Experiencing Uncertainty In These Areas Also! So Jesus

Removed This Uncertainty, By Identifying Himself As The One Who Has The Answers / Solutions To These Age-Old Questions / Problems!

- He Is The Source Of All Purpose!
  - "I Am The First And The Last!"
  - Teaches That There Is Noone Greater Than Him!
  - He Is Identified With The One True God!
    - Isaiah 44:1 "I the LORD, the first, and with the last; I am He!"
  - And As God, He Is The:
    - "First" The Preeminent One! Colossians 1:18 "And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence!"
  - And As God, He Is The:
    - "Last" The Perfect One!
    - Similar Idea: "Second" There Is No Third!
      - Second Appearance / Covenant / Veil / Man!
  - Jesus Alone Can Calm The Fear Of Uncertainty About Life When You Find Your Purpose In Him!
- He Is The Source Of All Life!
  - "I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen!"
  - Teaches His "Ever-Abiding Life!" (Thomas)
  - He Is Life!
    - "He That Liveth!" Present Tense
    - He Alone Can Create Life, Sustain Life, Renew Life! Because He Is Life!
  - He Did Die!
    - "And Was Dead!" Past Tense
    - His Death Was Actual, Historical, But Temporary!
    - Life Died! This Is The Gospel! Jesus Died Voluntarily, As A Substitute For Us!
  - He Is Alive!
    - "Alive For Evermore!"
    - This Speaks Of His Resurrection & Our Hope!
    - He Will Never Die Again! No Need To!
  - John 10:17-18 "Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. / No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father!"
  - Jesus Alone Can Calm The Fear Of Uncertainty About Death When You Find Your Life In Him!
- He Is The Source Of All Salvation!
  - "And have the keys of hell and of death!"
  - Two Keys: Only Jesus Holds These Keys!
    - The Key Of Death!
      - Death Is Fearful, Final, Hopeless & Unknown!
      - Opens The Door Of Fear!
      - Jesus Unlocked This Door For Himself, So That Others, Through Him, Need Not Fear!
    - The Key Of Hades!
      - The Place Of The Dead The Grave What Happens After Death? Annihilation / Reincarnation / Deification?
      - Opens The Door Of The Future!
  - Jesus Alone Can Calm The Fear Of Uncertainty About What Happens After Death When You Find Your Salvation In Him!

## 2. Through His Great Intelligence!

- 1:19 "Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter!"
  - Another Source Of Fear Is The Uncertainty Of Events In Life! But The Lord Jesus Can Calm

This Fear Also!

- Because He Knows & Is In Control Of:
- The Past!
  - "The Things Which Thou Hast Seen!"
    - Jesus Commands John Here To Write These Things, Because They Are True! Most See Here An Outline To Revelation But It Also Shows What God Knows & Reveals To John!
  - Everything John Heard & Saw Up Until Now!
    - Mostly A Description Of Jesus!
    - He Is The Reason We Can "Fear Not!"
- The Present!
  - "The Things Which Are!"
  - Most Likely, What Is Going On In The Churches Back Then & Now! Their Current Situation & Condition!
- The Future!
  - "The Things Which Shall Be Hereafter!"
  - Probably Everything After Revelation 4:1 "After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be *hereafter*!"
- Only Jesus Could Calm These Fears!
  - He Knows What Is Has Happened!
  - He Knows What Is Happening!
  - He Knows What Will Happen!
  - Because He Is In Control Of All That Happens!
    - And There's No Need To Fear!

### 3. Through His Great Illumination!

- 1:20 "The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches!"
  - There Are Many Secrets & Mysteries In This World!
    - And A Great Fear Of The Unknown!
    - But, Through The Lord's Illumination, He Can Calm This Fear As Well!
  - He Illuminates That Which Is Concealed! Mark 4:22 "There is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested; neither was any thing kept secret, but that it should come abroad!"
    - "Mystery" Secret Something "Beyond The Reach Of Natural Human Understanding And Can Only Be Grasped Through Special Revelation Through God's Spirit!" (Thomas)
- For The Christian!
  - "Seven Stars" = "Angels Of The Seven Churches"
    - "Angel" Messenger Either A Pastor / Leader / Messenger Of These Churches!
  - They Are In His Hand! No Need To Fear!
- For The Church!
  - "Seven Candlesticks" = "The Seven Churches"
  - They Are In His Presence! No Need To Fear!

#### **Conclusion:**

- 1. What Is Your Phobia?
  - The Lord Jesus Alone Can Calm Your Fears!
  - He Places His Hand On You, And Says: "Fear Not!"
    - Trust Me! "Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. / Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. / For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light!" (Mark 11:28-30)
