-Purpose: inculcate faith in Christ (20:30, 31)

-Distinctive Features: omits some things found in the synoptics; early Judean ministry; more theological; large didactic sections; I am sayings; Jesus' relation to the Father; emphasis on faith in Christ; washing of disciples' feet; Upper Room discourses; prayer in ch. 17; simple Greek; retrospective; Jesus' and John's words indistinguishable; irony

-Structure: Five Cycles: Jesus goes up to Jerusalem then withdraws (<u>Cycle #1</u>: 2:13, 4:3; <u>Cycle #2</u>: 5:1, 6:1; <u>Cycle #3</u>: 7:10, 10:40; <u>Cycle #4</u>: 11:7, 54; <u>Cycle #5</u>: 12:1, 21:1)
