# A Catechism for Bible Study

## for every Christian, young and old alike

1. **From where did the Bible come?**

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness (2 Timothy 3:16).

2. **Isn't the Bible just the work of holy men who wrote down their thoughts and ideas about God so that we could learn from their wisdom?**

For prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit (2 Peter 1:21).

3. **Why was the Bible written?**

And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name (John 20:30-31).

4. **Isn't the Bible just a book about morality and living a good life?**

These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God (1 John 5:13). Having the correct faith is so important because whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son (2 John 9).

5. **What can the Bible do for us?**

The Holy Scriptures are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus (2 Timothy 3:15).

6. **May God's words in the Bible ever be changed, or is He finished writing the Bible?**

For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book (Revelation 22:18-19).

7. **Whom did Jesus say would be blessed?**

Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book (Revelation 22:7).
