 - A. But now, a dramatic change has occurred. v. 13 (Eph. 2:4, Phil. 3:3, Is. 57:19, Jer. 5:15, Ps. 148:14, Gal. 3:28)
 - B. The precious blood of Christ has reconciled you to God. v. 13b (Rom. 5:10, 1 Pet. 3:18, Col. 1:20)
