A. Obedient children v. 14


What are some of the marks of our former sin and ignorance? 2:1-3

- 1. All malice
- 2. All deceit
- 3. Hypocrisies *Hupocritos*
- 4. Envies
- 5. All evil speaking
- B. Holy Ones (saints)
 - 1. We are "set apart" from the rest of the world.
 - 2. We are called to live "pure" lives in obedience to God.
- C. Another aspect of Holy is Conduct (anastrophe) v. 15
 - Conversation (KJV) archaic:
 - Behavior, manner of living, lifestyle
 - It refers to how we live our life.
 - We are talking about PRACTICAL HOLINESS.

The Greek word αναστοοφη appears more in Peter's epistles than in the rest of the New Testament combined.

v. 15 CONduct (noun) -- Verb form in v. 17 - conDUCT

Noun form = what you are to do -- **Verb form** = doing it
