I. When Christ comes, God’s anger turns away (12:1).

A. God’s anger with sin (Gen. 3:14-24; 6:5-7; Ex. 32:7-10; Lev. 10:1-3; 24:10-16; Ps. 95; 2 Chron. 34:22-25; Lam. 5; Rev. 6:12-17; 9:20-21; 22:12-13).

B. Your experience of God’s anger

1. Now in this life? (Pro. 11:31; Ps. 7:11)

2. Is God angry with Christians? (Ps. 32:1-5; Ps. 22:1; Ps. 60:1; 2 Sam. 11; Rev. 2-3, esp. 3:19; 1 Cor. 5:4-5; 1 Tim. 1:18-20)

C. Wonderful news.

1. God’s anger turns away (Mk. 15:33-34; Lk. 24:36-49; Acts 2:22-41; 10:34-48; 16:25-34)

2. God turns to comfort (Ro. 8:1, 10-11; Rev. 21:3-4).
