Romans 7:1-13

- I. Christ's Death, Our New Life (1-4)
 - A. The Law's power over the living
 - B. The metaphor of marriage
 - C. We have died to the Law, that we might live through Christ Jesus
- II. The Law Should Have Brought Life (5-12)
 - A. Sinful passions aroused by the Law
 - B. We have been released from the Law
 - C. The Law instructs us as to our sin
 - D. The Law is holy, but sin's effects on me by way of the Law produces wickedness in me
- III. Sin's Corruption Is Overpowered By God's Grace (13)
 - A. Is the Law my source of death? Is God's good Word my destruction? – Of course not.
 - B. Sin became utterly sinful...
 - C. But the free gift is not like the transgression – the resurrection undoes the power of sin and death
