Discussion Questions

The following questions are designed to be used by parents in discussing the sermon with their children, but can be used by anyone in discussing the sermon with others:

1. What stood out to you in this sermon? Why?
2. Where did the event in this passage take place? What kind of place was it?
3. Why did God create us with ears and a tongue?
4. Why are there handicaps and sickness today?
5. Why did Jesus put His fingers in the man's ears, and touch his tongue?
6. What did this miracle reveal about Jesus?
7. What will Christ do about handicaps and sickness in the future?
8. What is Christ doing now?

Going Deeper:

These questions are designed for the believer to use in prayer with his/her Lord, and in discussion with brothers and sisters in the Lord:

1. How did this sermon challenge your thinking, or grow your understanding?
2. Why did Christ charge people to tell no one about the miracle?
3. How does this passage show that it is possible to be in great awe of Christ, but not be one of His followers? How does this truth affect you?
4. How does your awe of Christ compare to the awe seen in verse 37? Explain.
5. How was this miracle a preview of what Christ will do in the future form of His kingdom?
6. How did this miracle picture what Christ is doing now?
7. Can you sincerely say from your heart that Christ has done all things well in His dealings with you, and in all other matters? Explain. Cf. verse 37.
8. How should you apply this sermon this week?
