Do Not Be Conformed Romans 12:2

Three commands are given to us who have received the mercies of God. The first command is that we offer ourselves to God as a sacrifice to Him. The second command is: *And do not be conformed to this world,*

There are two Greek words often translated into world: kosmos and gion.

- The word kosmos emphasizes the material world or the people in the world.
- The word aion means an age of time or eternity Romans 11:36

The meaning of *kosmos* and *aion* overlap when referring to world's ways that are contrary to God and His ways - **Ephesians 2:2**

- Christians are not of this kosmos John 17:16 They are not of the world, just as I
 am not of the world.
- Christians are not to love the kosmos or the things of the kosmos 1 John 2:15 Do
 not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love
 of the Father is not in him.
- The wisdom of this world is foolishness 1 Corinthians 1:20 Where is the wise?
 Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?

This aion is set in contrast to the age to come - Ephesians 1:21; 2:7

- This age is evil Galatians 1:4
- Satan is the god of this age 2 Corinthians 4:3-4; Ephesians 6:12 For we do not
 wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers,
 against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of
 wickedness in the heavenly places.
- The riches of this age are uncertain 1 Timothy 6:17
- When our lives are lived with only thinking of the time in this life, we are living according this age and not the one to come - 1 Peter 1:13-14

We are commanded not to be conformed to this age.

- To be conformed is to be shaped alike or pressed into the same pattern.
- We are not to be like a material being pressed or poured into a mold.
- The world is pressing us in on all sides forcing us to agree with its way of thinking, influencing our hearts to compromise, and tempting us to participate in the evil around us.

The Lord commands us to offer ourselves as a holy, living sacrifice acceptable to Him. That means that we must keep ourselves undefiled from the world's pollutions.

How has this world infected and affected your heart and mind? What do we need to do to break away from worldly thinking and activities?


