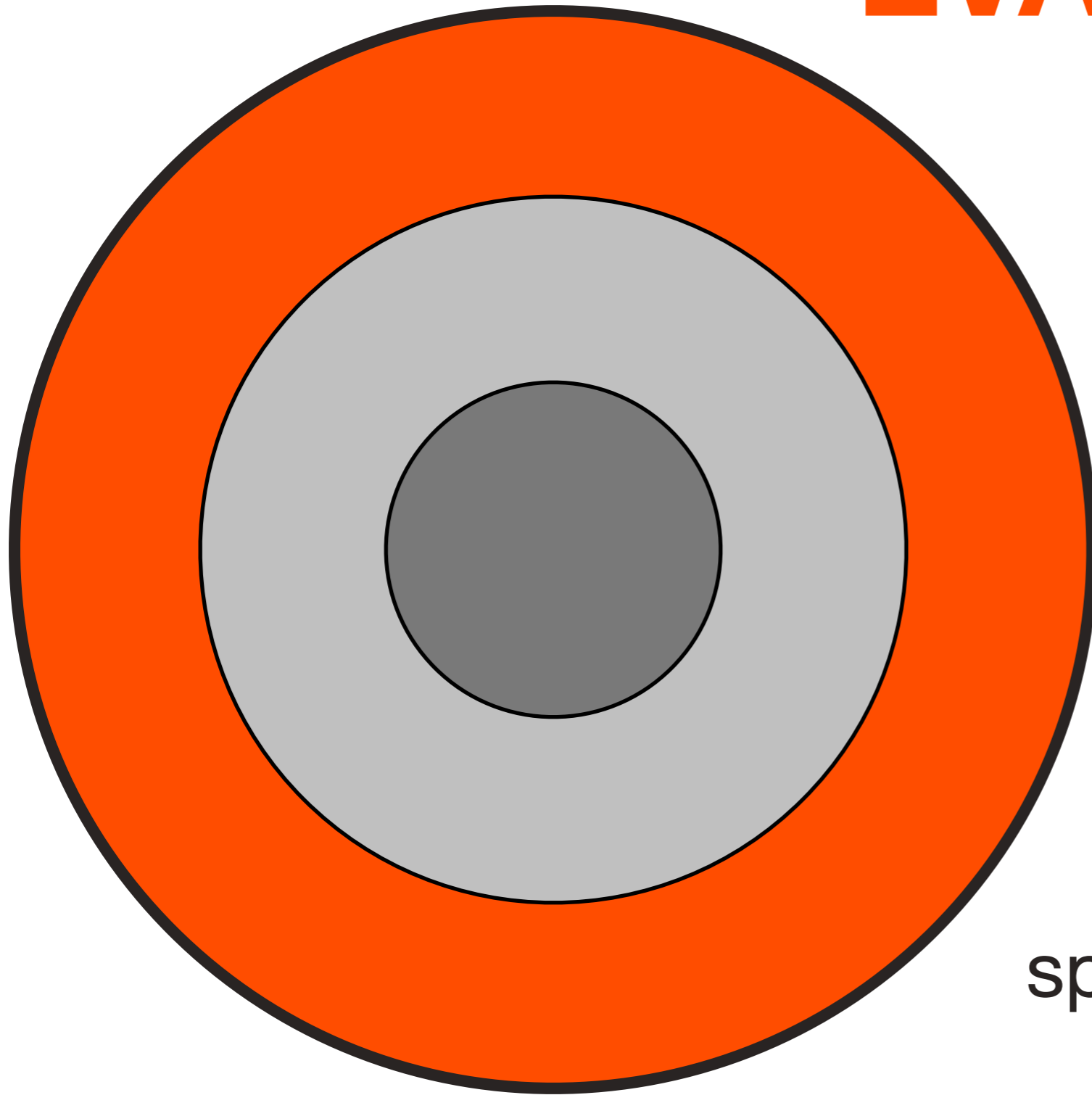
- To justify the place of Christian judgment in disciple-making

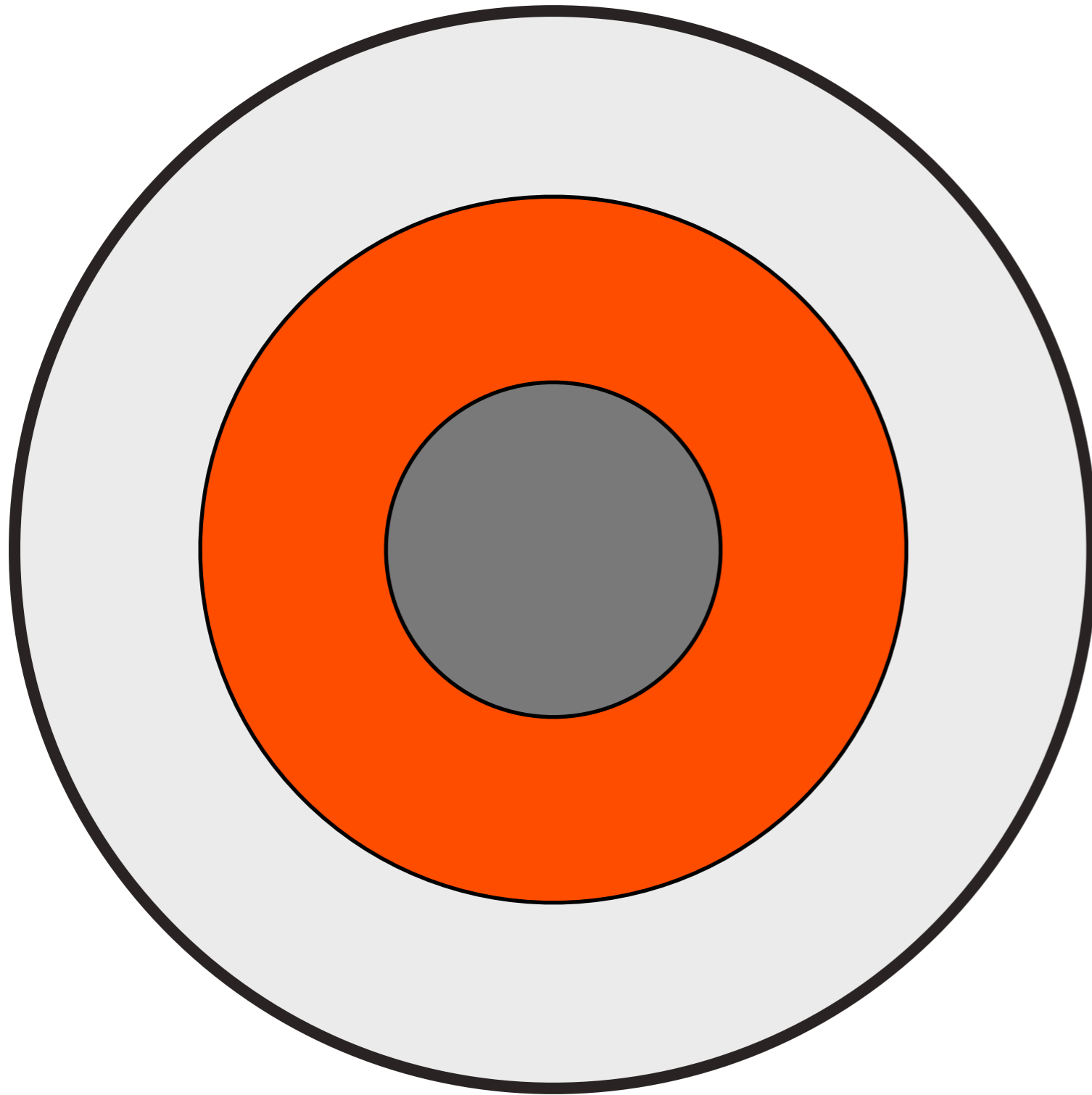

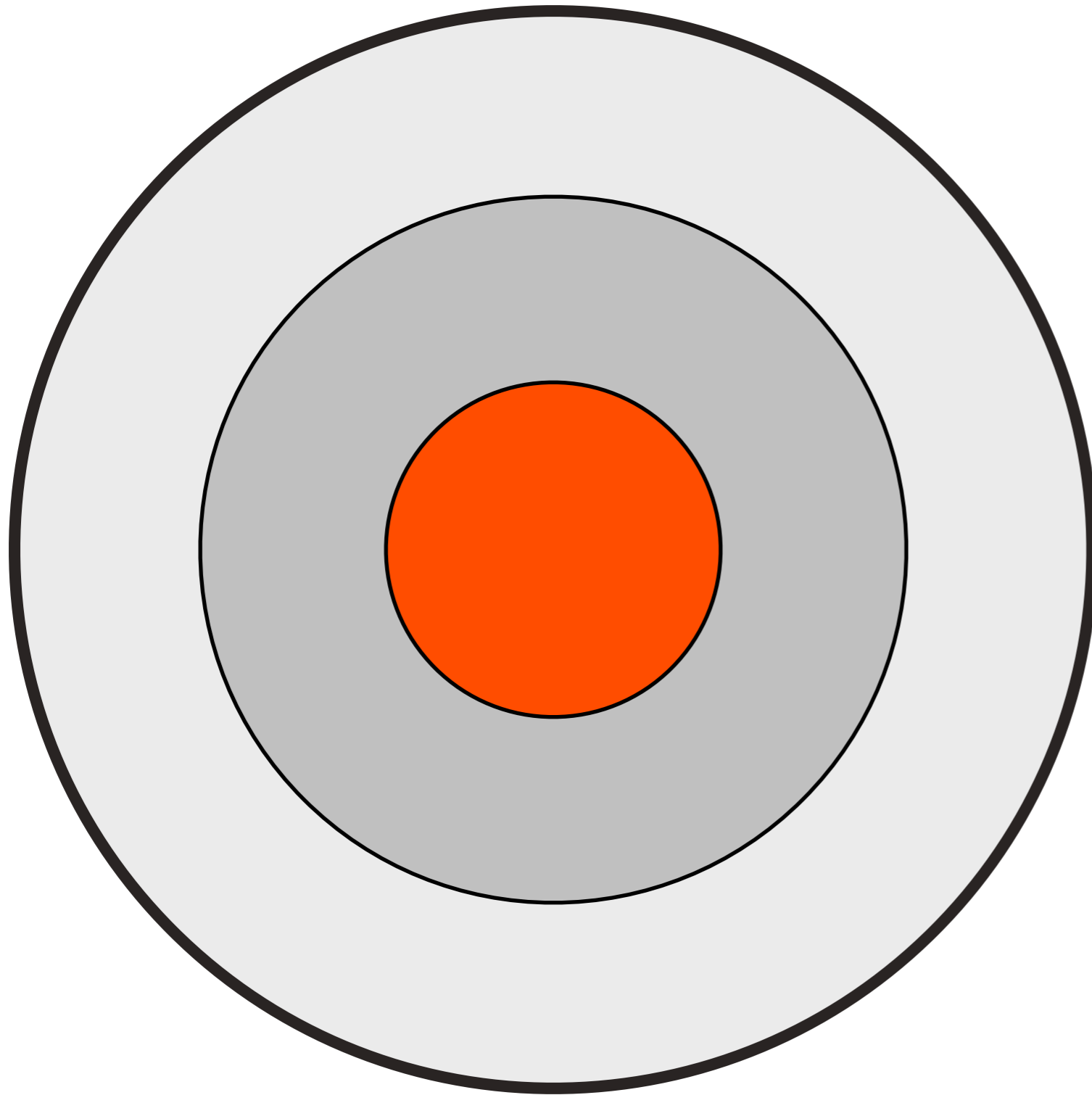

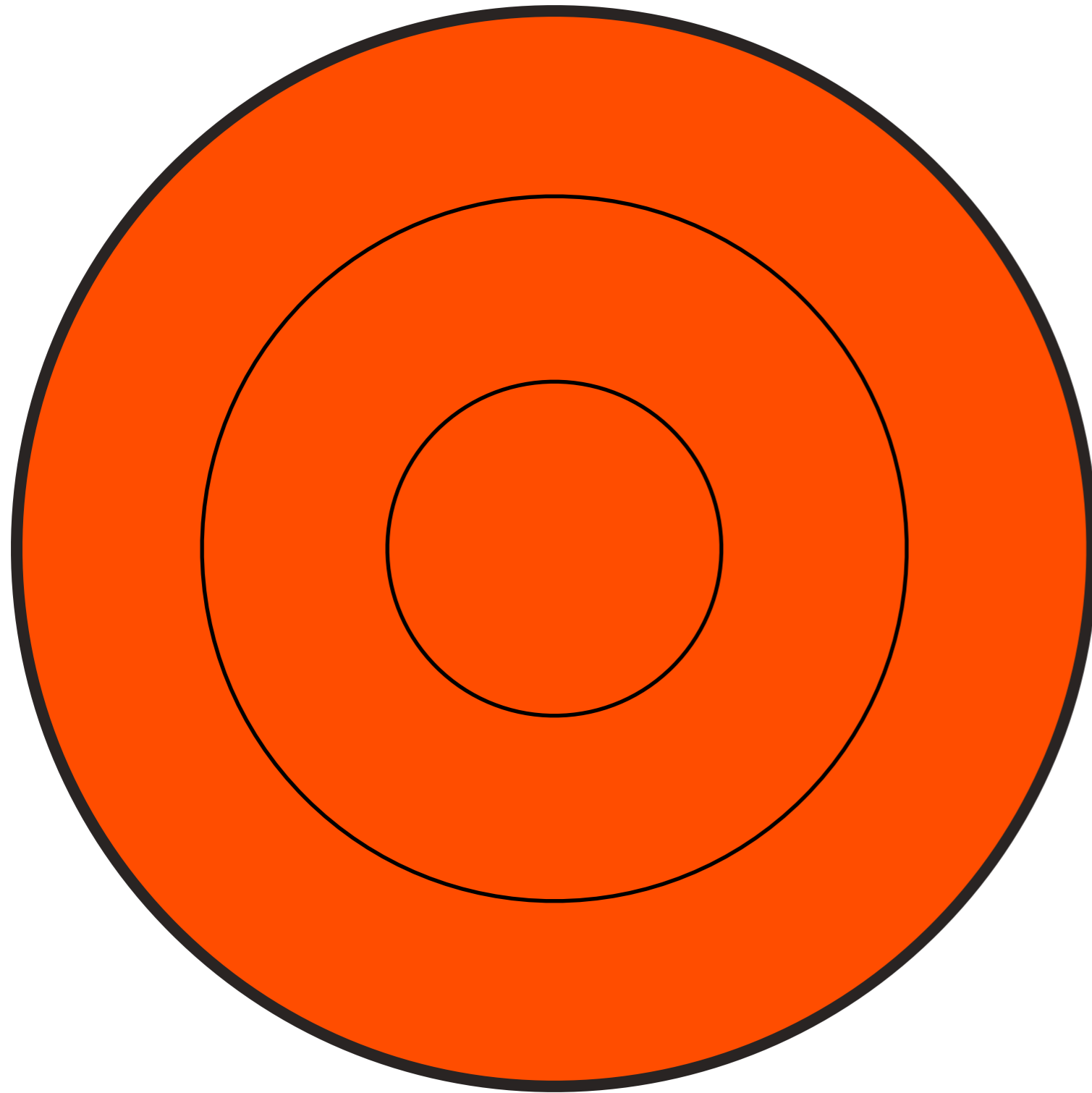
