**I. Non-Moral Attributes**

**A. Omnipresence** – Always present

1. Psalm 139:7; Acts 17:27-28; Jeremiah 23:23-24
2. Immensity – not limited by space

**B. Omniscience** – All knowing

1. Proverbs 15:3; Psalm 147:5; Hebrews 4:13

**C. Omnipotence** – All powerful

1. Matthew 28:18; Job 42:2; Genesis 18:14; Jeremiah 32:17,

27

**D. Immutability** – Unchanging

1. James 1:17; Malachi 3:6
2. Unchanging in His essence attributes consciousness & will

**II. Moral Attributes**

**A. Holiness**

1. Separate from moral evil & sin
2. 1 Peter 1:15-16, Leviticus 11:44-45

**B. Righteousness & Justice**

1. Holy in His treatment of His creation
2. 2 Timothy 4:8, Genesis 18:25

**C. Benevolence**

1. Love – 1 John 4:16; John 3:16
2. Goodness/Kindness – Romans 8:28, 2:4
3. Mercy – Ephesians 2:4
4. Grace – Ephesians 2:8-9, 1:7-8

**D. Truth**

1. John 14:6, 1 John 1:5
2. He is the foundation of all knowledge
