

# **Biblically Interpreting the SCOTUS Decision**

*(Pastor John Brackbill/Psalm 2 and Romans 1:18-32/6.28.15)*

*Lord's Table Worship Service*

**God is ruling over the SCOTUS decision to legalize “same-sex marriage” for the good of Christ’s preeminence in the lives of His people because He set His eternal love on us (Romans 8:28)**

**Those in the executive, legislative, and judicial branches of our government who pushed for this decision and who ruled in favor of this decision are responsible for their decision (Acts 2:22-23)**

**This decision is rage against God (Psalm 2:1-3)**

- It is a pointless rage
- It is an entrenched Rage
- It is a coordinated Rage
- It is a dual rage
- It is a rage of throwing off God’s restraints

**God is not moved by this decision which is a rage against Him (Psalm 2:4-6; Romans 1:18-32)**

- He is laughing at the rage in the decision (Psalm 2:4)
- He is righteously angry at this decision (Psalm 2:5, Romans 1:18-32)

**God the Father’s eternal decree that Jesus would rule over the nations is not changed because of this decision (Psalm 2:7-9)**

- Jesus will reign as the uniquely Davidic Son of God (7)
- Jesus will reign as the crucified and resurrected Son of God (7b)
- Jesus will one day be rewarded with the nations as His inheritance which He will rule over (8-9)
