Grown-Ups In The Room Pt.4: "Revelation We Don't Deserve."

I Text:

Old Covenant: *Jeremiah 31:31-40*

New Covenant: *1Peter 1:10-12*

II Doctrine: Prophecy in the Bible testifies of its authenticity. The prediction of the Messiah appearing on the earth to save mankind from their sins, is the centerpiece of prophesy. The Prophets themselves could not picture the full ramifications of the prophecies they were given. What a privilege for us to be given revelation we do not deserve, by Messiah himself. What a shame it is when believers neglect study of the scriptures, the knowledge Angels wished to have has been plainly revealed to us.

III Comparing Scripture With Scripture:

1) Prophecy in the Bible testifies of its authenticity. The prediction of the Messiah appearing on the earth to save mankind from their sins, is the centerpiece of prophesy. (*1Peter 1:10; Jeremiah 31:31-34*)
