Acts 13-14

- 1) Galatia: Pisidian Antioch, Iconium, Lystra, & Derbe (modern Turkey)
- 2) Paul's gospel: salvation by grace alone (Gal. 2:16)
- 3) What does the gospel comprise?
 - a) History from Abraham down to Jesus of Nazareth (13:16-41)
 - b) Proclamation of a Savior, Jesus Christ (13:25)
 - c) That the Savior died and was resurrected (13:28-30)
 - d) That the resurrected Savior appeared alive to many for many days (13:31)
 - e) That the risen Christ is a fulfillment of Scripture (13:32-37)
 - f) That Christ alone grants forgiveness of sins, not compliance to the Law (13:38-39)
 - g) That those who believe were appointed for such (13:48)
- 4) Some, not all, will believe the gospel (14:1-4, 8, 21-22)
 - a) The enemies of the gospel desire death for God's people (14:5, 19)
 - b) Some misunderstand the gospel completely (14:11-18)
- 5) The gospel is free, and it produces fruit
 - a) The fruit of strengthening souls (14:22a)
 - b) The fruit of persecution (14:22b)
