## "A Call For Commitment" Romans 12:1-2

- 1. We Come This Morning:
  - To A New Chapter:
    - In Our Study Through The Book Of Romans:
      - Which Is Also:
        - The Beginning Of:
          - An Entirely New Section:
            - In The Book!
- 2. So Let's Turn In Our Bibles To:
  - Romans 12 Where:
    - As You Can See On Your Message Guide:
      - We Are Going To Be Looking At:
        - Just Two Verses!
  - But These Verses:
    - Are Likely *Not* Unfamiliar To You:
      - Because They Are The Apostle Paul's:
        - Great Call For Commitment!
      - A Call *To* Christians:
        - *For* Commitment:
          - To Christ!
- 3. Let's Read These Verses Together:
  - Romans 12:1-2:
    - "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. / And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God!"
  - This Morning:
    - As We Explore These Notable Verses:
      - I Want Us To Both Hear & Heed:
        - This Call For Commitment:
          - In A Fresh, New Way!
- 4. Because It Seems Like:
  - It Is So Easy For Us:
    - Even As Christians:
      - To Be Committed To Anything & Everything:
        - But Our Own Namesake:
          - Christ Himself!
  - IE: After All The World Calls For Your Commitment All The Time, Doesn't It?
    - Every Four Years When Its "Political Season" The Country Calls On You To Make A Decision About Who You Think Should Be The Next President Of The United States! But Even More Than That Voices From Every Side Call On You To Make A Commitment! Don't Just Make A Choice! Take A Side! And For Far Too Many Professing Christians, Politics Has Become Their Religion!
      - Its To You, This Morning, That We Bring This Appeal From The Apostle Paul:
        - "I Beseech You Therefore, Brethren!"
          - But You Don't Even Have To Wait Four Years To Hear This Call For Commitment From The World!
    - Every Season Of The Year Whether Its Baseball Season Or Football Season Or Basketball Season! Fans From All Teams Call On You To Make A Commitment!
      - Invest Your Time! Invest Your Energy! Invest Your Money! Even To The Point Where Again For Far Too Many Professing Christians:
        - Sports Has Become Their Religion!
          - And It Is To You Too, That We Bring This Appeal From The Apostle Paul:
            - "I Beseech You Therefore, Brethren!"
    - You Many Not Be Very Political! You May Not Be Into Sports! But There Are Other People & Other Organizations & Other Of Your Own Desires That Are All Vying For Your Commitment!

- And Again For Far Too Many Of Us:
  - Our Commitment To Them:
    - Has Become Far Greater:
      - Than Our Commitment To Our Savior:
        - The Lord Jesus Christ!

- 5. It Is To All Of Us:
  - That The Apostle Paul Brings His Appeal:
    - 12:1 "I Beseech You Therefore, Brethren, By The Mercies Of God, That Ye Present Your Bodies A Sacrifice!"
      - Now That's A Call For Commitment!
        - IE: This Call Would Have Been Understood By Just About Everyone In Paul's Day!
          - Because Just About Everyone Had, At One Time Or Another, Been Involved In Making Sacrifices To Their Gods!
  - Of Course The Jews:
    - Were Given Instructions By God:
      - To Offer Sacrifices:
        - For Just About Any Reason Imaginable! There Were Burnt Offerings & Sin Offerings! Peace Offerings & Even Drink Offerings!
          - And Most Of Those Offerings Were Of Animals:
            - Whose Lives Were Taken & Whose Blood Was Shed!
  - The Gentiles And Especially The Romans:
    - Had Dozens Of False Gods & Goddesses:
      - That They Would Have Offered Sacrifices To!
        - Which Also Included:
          - The Offering Of Animals & Sometimes Even People:
            - To Appease The Wrath Of Their Gods!
  - And Though The Religious Differences:
    - Between Those Sacrifices Were Great:
      - There Was One Thing:
        - They Usually Had In Common!
    - And That Was:
      - Whatever They Offered As A Sacrifice:
        - Was Given Completely & In Its Entirety To Be Consumed On The Altar!
          - And That's Commitment!
- 6. So Here In Romans 12:
  - We Find A Call For Commitment:
    - In Similar Terms!
      - But This Sacrifice:
        - Is Not:
          - A Sacrifice Of Animals!
        - Nor Is It:
          - A Sacrifice Of Possessions!
        - It Is A Sacrifice:
          - Of Yourself And:
            - Your Own Body!
  - 12:1 "I Beseech You Therefore, Brethren That Ye Present Your Bodies As A Sacrifice!"
    - And If You Offer To The Lord:
      - Your Body That Includes:
        - Everything That Goes Along With Your Body!
          - Your Body & Soul & Spirit!
          - Your Mind & Heart & Will!
      - Back In 6:13 We Were Told In Similar Terms:
        - "But yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God!"
    - In Other Words:
      - God Desires *All* Of You:
        - To Be Committed To Him!
          - And Doesn't God Deserve:

- 7. Paul Thinks He Does!
  - This Is Why At The Beginning Of This New Chapter And:
    - At The Beginning Of This New Section:
      - He Uses That One Word:
        - "Therefore" To Tie It All Together!
  - "Therefore" Points Back:
    - To Everything He Has Already Written:
      - In Chapters 1-11!
    - Which Essentially Tells Us About:
      - The Greatness & The Goodness Of God:
        - In Offering Salvation & Justification To Sinners Like Us:
          - Through Faith Alone In Jesus Christ!
    - And If You Have Received:
      - And Believed In This Gospel:
        - 1:16 "It Is The Power Of God Unto Salvation!"
          - Your Salvation!
            - Have You?

- If So Then:
  - Whereas In Chapters 1-11:
    - We Are Told:
      - How To Be Right With God!
    - In Chapter 12 And Following:
      - We Are Told:
        - How To Live Right For God!
  - So Paul Now Turns From:
    - An Explanation:
      - Of The Gospel To:
        - The Expectations:
          - Of The Gospel!
- 8. And One Of Those Expectations:
  - Is Commitment!
    - As A Christian Your Primary Commitment:
      - Is Now To Be:
        - To Christ!
  - And The First Think We Find:
    - In Romans 12:1 Is That:
- 1. There Is A Great Motive For Your Commitment To Christ!
  - And That Motive Is:
    - "The Mercies Of God!"
      - Again 12:1 "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice!"
    - **IE:** When You Make A Commitment To Something Or Somebody There Is Usually Something In It For You! Even When You Are A Committed Fan Of Some Team That's Terrible Like The Pacers There's A Reason For Your Commitment That Will Keep You As A Fan No Matter How May Disappointing Seasons They May Have!
      - Well As A Christian:
        - You Have An Infinitely Greater Reason & Motive:
          - To Be 100% Committed To Christ!
            - "The Mercies And The Compassion Of God!"
              - And:
  - The Mercies Of God Are Supreme!
    - That Is They Are Great!
      - Just Think About The Book Of Romans Itself!
        - Isn't It Just An Explanation:
          - Of God's Mercy To Sinners:
            - Like All Of Us?

- You Owe Your Very Salvation:
  - To The Mercy Of God!
    - As Paul Told Us Back In 9:16:
      - "So then it is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy!"
- And The Mercy Of God:
  - To Save You:
    - Is Your Motive:
      - For Your Commitment To Christ!
        - But Also:
- The Mercies Of God Are Substantial!
  - The Word "Mercy" Here:
    - Is In The Plural "Mercies" Not Only Because:
      - They Are Supreme But Because:
        - They Are Substantial & Many!
  - Back In 11:33:
    - In Paul's Doxology:
      - He Expressed His Wonder About:
        - "The Depth Of The Riches Of God!"
  - And Those "Riches" Include:
    - 2:4 "The riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering!"
      - All Of Which God Used To:
        - "Lead You To Repentance!"
  - And So The Mercies Of God:
    - Displayed To You:
      - Not Only At Your Salvation But Even After Your Salvation:
        - Is Your Motive:
          - For Your Commitment To Christ! But Also:
- The Mercies Of God Are Sure!
  - That Is They Are Permanent & Lasting!
    - In Lamentations 3:21-23:
      - The Prophet Jeremiah Understood This, When He Wrote "This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope. / It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. / They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness!"
- This Is The Great Motive:
  - For Your Commitment To Christ!
    - "The Mercies Of God!"
      - Like Jeremiah You Need To:
        - Daily "Recall To Your Mind" His Tender Mercies To You!
  - And Because Of His Mercies:
    - Re-Commit & Re-Dedicate Yourself To Him:
      - Each & Every Day!
        - After All Is There Anyone Else Or Anything Else:
          - Who Has Given You Such Mercy As The Lord?
  - But Then As We Continue In Romans 12:1:
    - We Find That:
- 2. There Is A Great Meaning To Your Commitment To Christ!
  - And That Meaning Is:
    - Found At The End Of 12:1:
      - Where Paul Describes The Kind Of Sacrifice:
        - God Is Looking For!
          - It's A "Living Sacrifice, Holy, Acceptable Unto God, Which Is Your Reasonable Service!"
    - This Is The Kind Of Commitment:
      - God Desires From You And:
        - The Kind Of Commitment:
          - God Deserves From You!

- A Devoted Commitment!
  - This Is Why Paul First Describes:
    - Our Christian "Sacrifice" As A:
      - "Living Sacrifice!"
  - This Means That:
    - You Offer Yourself To The Lord:
      - Willingly!
        - IE: Unlike Some Of The Animals That Were Dragged To Their Deaths!
  - This Also Means That:
    - You Offer Yourself To The Lord:
      - Perpetually!
        - IE: Unlike The Once And For All Sacrifice Of Animals!
  - To Be A "Living Sacrifice" Means:
    - To Live Your Entire Life:
      - In Devotion To The Lord!
        - **IE:** Much Like The Prophet Samuel When He Was Offered By His Mother, Hannah, To The Lord! A "Living Sacrifice" Of Thanksgiving!
  - Are You Living Your Life:
    - In Devotion To The Lord?
      - The Mercies Of God Call For:
        - Nothing Less! It Is Also To Be:
- A Distinct Commitment!
  - This Is Why Paul Goes On To Describe:
    - Our Christian Sacrifice As A:
      - "Holy" Sacrifice!"
  - To Be "Holy" Means:
    - Set Apart To God:
      - And For His Service!
        - Does This Describe Your Life Before The Lord?
  - Even Though:
    - There Are Many Different Roles & Responsibilities That You Have In Your Life And:
      - Many Commitments That You Need To Maintain!
        - Yet Doesn't God Deserve To Be Your Number One Priority?
          - Because Of All Of His Grace & Mercy To You?
  - And Yet How "Distinct" And "Holy" Is:
    - Your Commitment To Him?
      - As Frances Havergal Reminds Us In A Hymn:
        - I gave My life for thee,

My precious blood I shed,

That thou mightst ransomed be,

And quickened from the dead;

I gave, I gave My life for thee,

What hast thou done for Me?

I gave, I gave My life for thee,

What hast thou done for Me?

- Are You Living Your Life:
  - In A Distinct Way For The Lord?
    - The Mercies Of God Call For:
      - Nothing Less! It Is Also To Be:
- A Desirable Commitment!
  - This Is Why Paul Further Describes:
    - Your Christian Sacrifice As One:
      - That Is "Acceptable Unto God!"
        - Or "Well-Pleasing" Unto God!
  - Now What Kind Of Offering:
    - Is "Well-Pleasing" To God Today?
      - What Kind Of Offering Is:

- A Sweet-Smelling Savour:
  - To Him?
- I Think It's The Same Kind Of Offering:
  - That God Wanted Even Back In The Old Testament!
    - An Offering Offered:
      - In Faith & In Hope & In Love!
- Even King David Understood That:
  - It Wasn't The Offering Alone:
    - That God Wanted! It Was:
      - The Offeror!
  - In Psalm 51:16-17 "For thou desirest not sacrifice; else would I give it: thou delightest not in burnt offering. / The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise!"
- You See An "Acceptable" Sacrifice To The Lord:
  - Is A Sacrifice From Your Heart!
    - It Is A Simple & A Sincere & A Spiritual Sacrifice!
      - IE: Its Like The Widow & Her Two Mites! Its Like The Woman Who Gave Up Her Only Precious Possession "An Alabaster Box Of Ointment Of Spikenard Very Precious" That She "Brake & Poured It On Jesus' Head!" (Mark 14) And What Did Jesus Say About Her? "She Hath Done What She Could!"
- This Is What God Desires From You!
  - This Is The Kind Of Sacrifice That Is "Acceptable Unto God!"
    - Its Not What:
      - Others Can Offer!
    - Its What:
      - You Can Offer!
        - From Your Heart, Through Your Hands, To His Honor!
- Are You Living Your Life:
  - According To The Lord's Desire?
    - The Mercies Of God Call For:
      - Nothing Less! But Also Its To Be:
- A Deliberate Commitment!
  - At The End Of 12:1 Paul Describes This Entire Offering:
    - As "Your Reasonable Service!"
  - In Old Testament Times:
    - The Priests, Who Were From The Tribe Of Levi:
      - Were Responsible For The Offerings & Sacrifices That The People Would Bring!
  - But Now As Part Of:
    - A New & "Holy Priesthood":
      - You Are Personally Responsible:
        - To Offer Yourself To The Lord:
          - As A Christian!
    - This Is The "Service" That:
      - You And I Are Called To!
        - Not Just Here At Church:
          - But At Work & At Home & Out & About In The World!
  - Your Service To God:
    - Is More Than:
      - Going To A Service!
      - Giving At A Service!
      - Greeting In A Service!
      - Even Glorifying God At A Service!
  - Your Service To God:
    - Is A Life Of Service!
      - And Paul Describes This As:
        - "Reasonable!"
          - In Other Words In Light Of The Mercy & Mercies Of God To You:

### - It Just Makes Sense!

- This Is To Be The Great Meaning:
  - Of Your Commitment To Christ:
    - As A Christian!
  - Every Single Day:
    - Commit Yourself Afresh To The Lord:
      - As A "Living Sacrifice, Holy, Acceptable Unto God, Which Is Your Reasonable Service!"
  - Every Singe Day:
    - Offer Yourself To The Lord:
      - In This Kind Of Devoted, Distinct, Desirable, And Deliberate Way!
        - But How Can We Even Do This?
  - See Next In 12:2:

# 3. There Is A Great Manner In Your Commitment To Christ!

- And That Manner Is:
  - Found At The Beginning Of 12:2:
    - "And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind!"
      - True Commitment To Christ:
        - Based On God & His Mercy To You:
          - Involves Two Things!
  - First It Involves:
- A Resistance To The World!
  - Paul Tells Us:
    - "Be Not Conformed To This World!"
      - The Word Translated World:
        - Can Also Be Translated:
          - "Age!"
  - This Is A Good Way To Describe:
    - The Temporary & Transitory Nature:
      - Of The World In Which We Live!
    - Just Like In Paul's Day:
      - In Our Day & Age:
        - The World has Its Own Spirit & Focus & Culture & Sins & Pressures & Influences!
    - This World Is Very Good At:
      - Consuming Our Minds & Hearts & Time!
        - To Take Away Our Commitment To Christ!
  - But Paul Says:
    - As Part Of Our Commitment:
      - Do Not Let The Pressures & Pleasures Of This World:
        - Squeeze You Into Its Mold And:
          - Conform You Into His Shape!
  - IE: What Is The World Doing Today To Express Its Independence From God & Its Insolence To God:
    - At This Present Time? Think About Its Amusements & Apparel & Associations!
      - Even If Not Sinful In & Of Themselves:
        - If You Are Absorbed By These Things To The Neglect Of Your Responsibilities To God:
          - You Are Being Conformed To This World!
  - There Is To Be In Us:
    - A Certain Kind Of Defiance:
      - When It Comes To This World!
        - And A Certain Kind Of Difference & Resistance:
          - In Order To Be Truly Committed To Christ!
  - But Then This Manner Also Involves:
- A Renewal By The Lord!
  - Paul Continues In 12:2 And Tells Us:
    - "But be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind!"

- In Other Words:
  - Let The Change:
    - That God Has Started In Your Life Through The Gospel:
      - Continue!
- The Word Translated "Transform" Here:
  - Was Also Used Of Jesus:
    - When He Was Transfigured On The Mountain:
      - Before His Disciples, Peter & James & John!
  - And Though Our "Transformation" May Seem To Be Far Less Dramatic:
    - Yet It Will Be No Less Visible:
      - As People Recognize That You Are One Who Has Been With Jesus!
- And This Great Transformation:
  - Can Only Come Through:
    - The "Renewing Of Your Mind!"
      - Which Is One Of The Reasons Why We Meet Together:
        - On The Lord's Day!
  - Because You Recognize That:
    - You Need Renewal!
      - Not Just Today, But Every Day!
        - And This Renewal Comes Through:
          - Exposure To God & His Word!

- And This Is The Great Manner:
  - Of Your Commitment To Christ:
    - As A Christian!
  - Every Single Day:
    - Make A Conscious Choice:
      - By God's Grace & Through His Strength:
    - To Resist:
      - Being Conformed To This World! And:
    - To Be Renewed:
      - And Transformed:
        - More & More Into:
          - The Image Of Christ Himself!
  - Because Then You Will See That:
- 4. There Is A Great Mission For Your Commitment To Christ!
  - As We See At The End Of:
    - 12:2 "That ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God!"
      - One Thing That The World & The Devil:
        - Wants To Convince Christians Of:
          - Is That Its Not Worth It:
            - To Be Committed To Christ!
      - But The Truth Is:
        - Only Christ Is Worthy Of Your Commitment!
    - And What Paul Is Telling Us Here:
      - Is That When You Do:
        - Fully Commit Yourself To The Lord:
          - He Will Not Let You Down!
            - Instead You Will "Prove What Is The Will Of God!"
    - Now This Does Not Mean:
      - That You Will Have All Of The Answers:
        - About What God Wants You To Do:
          - With Your Life!
        - Its Not Talking About:
          - The Unknown Will Of God!
      - Instead Its Talking About:
        - The Known Will Of God:

- Which Is Found In His Word!
- The Same Will:
  - That Tells Us To:
  - 12:1 "Present Your Bodies A Living Sacrifice, Holy, Acceptable Unto God!"
- Well The World Will Try To Get You To Think That:
  - This Kind Of Sold-Out Commitment To Christ:
    - Is Not What's Best For You!
      - The World Will Try To Get You To Think That God's Will & Even God Himself:
        - Is Not Good & Not Out For Your Good!
- But When Your Mind:
  - Is Renewed You Will See More & More That:
- God's Will Is Good!
  - And Is Always Good!
    - To "Prove" Here Means To Test:
      - And Find True & Genuine!
        - IE: Like Armor Was "Proven" In Ancient Times!
  - The More You Commit Yourself & Your Life:
    - To The Lord The More You Will Be Convinced:
      - Of The Goodness Of God & His Will:
        - For Your Life!
  - Don't Let The World:
    - Convince You Otherwise!
      - Also The World Will Try To Get You To Think That:
        - Commitment To The Lord:
          - Is No Fun & That You Will Miss Out On So Much In This Life!
  - But When You:
    - Resist The World & Are Renewed By The Lord:
      - You Will See More & More That:
- God's Will Is Acceptable!
  - Same Word As In 12:1:
    - "Well-Pleasing!"
      - Only I Don't Think Here:
        - It Is Referring To What Is "Well-Pleasing" To God But:
          - What Is "Well-Pleasing" To His People!
  - Because You Will Find:
    - When You Are Truly Committed To Christ:
      - That What Is Well-Pleasing To God:
        - Is Well-Pleasing To His People, And To You!
  - John Piper Famous Quote:
    - "God Is Most Glorified in Us When We Are Most Satisfied in Him!"
      - But I Think The Reverse Is Also True!
        - You Will Be Most Satisfied In God & Satisfied In Life:
          - When God Is Most Glorified In You & Your Commitment To Him!
  - But The World Will Also Want You To Think:
    - That God Is Not Worthy Of Your Trust & Commitment:
      - Because Just Look Around You:
        - He's Not In Control!
    - Even Those Who Have:
      - Committed Themselves Wholly To God:
        - What Did They Get? How Did They End Up?
  - But When You Do Commit Yourself To The Lord:
    - As A "Living Sacrifice" You Will Find:
      - More And More That:
- God's Will Is Perfect!
  - And You Can Be Confident:
    - As Paul Was In Philippians 1:6 "Oof this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform [it] until the day of Jesus Christ!"

- And This Is The Great Mission:
  - Of Your Commitment To Christ:
    - As A Christian!

## **Conclusion:**

- 1. When You Do:
  - Present Yourself To God:
    - As This Kind Of Sacrifice:
      - You Will Not Be Disappointed!
        - Day After Day:
          - You Will Prove To Yourself & To Others That God's Will:
            - Is Good & Is Acceptable & Is Perfect!

- 2. So This Morning:
  - Will You Hear This Call Once Again?
    - But Even More Will You Heed It?
      - Renew Your Commitment To Christ!
        - Today & Every Day!

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
