John 14:15-24 Loving the Trinity

How can we live for God in a world that is troubled by hatred of God?

The love of the Trinity energizes our love for the Trinity.

- 1) Love for the Trinity is demonstrated by obedience to God's Word (14:15, 21, 23, 24).
 - a) My commandments (2x), My word, My words—not only the ethical precepts of Jesus, but the totality of His revelation of God, which is also the Father's Word
 - b) "keep" and "have" is both to possess as a treasure and to put into practice
 - c) Love for Christ is inseparable from obedience to His Word.
 - d) How can people like us, beset by sinful desires and a hostile world love like this?
- 2) Love for the Trinity is energized by the love of the Trinity (14:16-24).
 - a) The love of the Trinity is first inner-Trinitarian (14:20a).
 - b) We are brought into the inner-Trinitarian love through our union with Christ—the Word who became flesh, 1:1, 14 (14:17, 20, 21b, 23a).
 - c) The love of God is an active energy that goes out to us with effect: 14:18—"I will not leave you as orphans (destitute)."
 - i) God's love grants true knowledge of God—Divine Revelation.
 - (1) 14:16-17—"Helper . . . the Spirit of Truth"—*Parakletos* most likely background is judicial; "friend in court"; "strengthening companion" (Borchert); legal counsel for a witness; He discloses the treasures of Christ to us so that we can testify against the world for Christ
 - (2) 14:19-21—"you will see Me" (post-resurrection appearances to elect); "in that day you will know that I am in the Father" (insight into the Person of Christ as Divine and into the Trinitarian nature of God); "I will manifest Myself to him" (self-disclosure of Christ)
 - ii) God's love ensures the permanent presence of God.
 - (1) 14:17—"He dwells with you and will be in you"
 - (2) 14:18—"I will come to you" (resurrection)
 - (3) 14:20—"you in Me and I in you"
 - (4) 14:23—"My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him"
 - iii) God's love sustains the Godward life. 14:19—"Because I live, you also will live."
 - iv) God's love for us energizes our love for Him. Notice the Trinitarian structure of Christ's promise in verse 16: "I, for My part, will ask the <u>Father</u>, and <u>He</u> will give you another <u>Paraklete</u>, that <u>He</u> might be with you forever."

Are you treasuring the Word of Christ? Is your ignorance of God a symptom of your indifference to God? Let us not neglect so great a salvation.
