## "Complete In Him" Colossians 2:8-10

#### **Introduction:**

- 1. How Many Times In Your Life:
  - Have You Heard This Old Saying?
    - "An Ounce Of Prevention Is Worth A Pound Of Cure!"
      - Even Though You've Probably Heard This Adage Many Times:
        - How May Times Have You Applied It In Your Own Life & To Your Own Health?
  - Yet Over & Over Again:
    - The Truth Of This Proverb:
      - Haunts Us As We Go Through Life!
        - Especially When We Think Of All The "Preventions" That We Could Have Taken:
          - But Didn't, Until It Was Too Late!
- 2. Well The Lord Knows Our Nature:
  - And Wants Us To Apply This Same Truth:
    - In Our Walk With Him As Well!
      - Especially When It Comes To The Temptations Of Sin & The Trials Of Error:
        - That Are All Around Us!
  - And This Is Why:
    - Paul Wrote The Verses That We Will Come To This Morning:
      - To The Colossian Church Nearly Two Thousand Years Ago!
        - To Remind Them & Us That "Prevention" Really Is The "Best Medicine" In Our Christian Lives As Well!
- 3. So Let's Turn Back In Our Bibles This Morning:
  - To Colossians 2 Where Paul Is Getting To:
    - The Very Heart Of The Reason:
      - Of Why He Wrote This Letter To The Colossians!
  - It Was Because:
    - He Cared For The Condition:
      - Of Those Christians!
        - And Because There Was A Threat Of Error At Their Threshold And If They Let It In
        - It Would Wreak Havoc In Their Young & Small Church!
- 4. So There Are Two Key Commands:
  - That Paul Gives Them And Us:
    - To Help "Prevent" Error From Invading & Infecting The Body Of Christ!
  - The First Command:
    - We Looked At Last Week:
      - From 2:6 Where Paul Writes:
        - "As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him!"
    - So The First Medicine:
      - Of Prevention Is:
        - To Walk! And To Walk In Christ!
          - Day By Day & Moment By Moment In Fellowship With Your Savior!
    - This Really Is:
      - The Best Prevention:
        - For Any Error & For Any Sin!
          - Have You Been Walking In & With Jesus This Week?
        - But Then We Come To:
  - The Second Command:
    - Which We Find:
      - In 2:8 Where Paul Adds:
        - "Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit!"
    - The Word "Beware" Here:
      - Is Also A Command Which In Other Places:
        - Is Translated "Take Heed!"
          - It Means To Watch! To Pay Attention:
            - And To Be Watching While You Are Walking!

- **IE:** Because Just Like Any Walk Or Hike You May Go On, There Are Thinks You Need To Watch Out For! Remember Going On Hikes Through The Woods Needed To Watch Your Feet Rocks & Holes But Also Needed To Watch Your Head For The Branch That Someone Ahead Of You Forgot To Tell You About!
  - Even Though When You Walk With Christ It Is The Spiritually Safest & Straightest & Sweetest Path:
    - There Are Still Dangers Along That Path That You Need To Watch Out For:
      - So That You Stay On His Path!
- So These Two Commands To Walk & To Watch:
  - Have Been Given To You:
    - To Prevent You From Going Down The Wrong Path & To Prevent You From Tasting:
      - The Poison Of Sin & Error!
        - So Keep Watching As You Are Walking With Christ!
- 5. And What Are You To Watch Out For?
  - 2:8 "Beware lest any man spoil you!"
    - This Is A Clear Warning Signal From The Apostle Paul!
      - **IE:** It Is Like The Recent Tornado Warnings & Sirens That Were Meant To Alert People To Danger! In Ohio, As A Meteorologist Was Making His Report On TV, The Station Cut Into A Popular Show Called "The Bachelor" People Started Complaining! And That Poor Meteorologist Had Enough And Started Chastising His Audience For Caring More For A TV Program Than For The Lives Of Their Fellow Buckeyes!
        - Here Paul Is Interrupting The Status Quo Of Our Lives In Order To Remind Us That There Is Real Danger Out There!
          - There Really Are Threats To Your Spiritual Life!
  - And What Are Those Threats Wanting To Do?
    - To "Spoil You!"
      - This Does Not Mean That They Want To:
        - Ruin You Like The Spoiling Of Fruit:
          - But They Want To Take You Away As Their Own Prey! To Take You As The Spoil Of A Battle In Which You Lost!
    - Much Like Peter Describes The Devil:
      - In 1 Peter 5:8 "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour!"
        - You Need To Remember That:
          - The Devil Is Always At The Door & The Enemy Is Always At The Gate!
  - And This Is Why You And I Need To:
    - Keep Walking With Christ:
      - And Keep Watching!
        - As Jesus Tells Us In Mark 14:38 "Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is weak!"
- 6. You Need To Keep Watching As You Are Walking With Christ!
  - And In The Rest Of 2:8 Through 2:10 Paul Gives Us A Couple Of Reasons Why!
    - Because The Devil & His Servants:
      - Are Trying To *Captivate* You:
        - And Draw You Away From Your Walk With Christ!
          - And They May Do This In Different Ways & With Different Things!
            - But They Are Always Trying To Lure You Off The Pathway Of Christ!
  - And The Question I Want You To Consider This Morning:
    - Is This Has This Happened To You Already?
      - Is This Going On Already In Your Life?
        - Have You Stopped Walking With Christ Because You Have Stopped Watching Out:
          - For Those Who Want To "Spoil You" By Captivating You With Other Things?
    - What Are You Captivated By?
- \* First Have You Been Captivated By:
- 1. What Is Futile?
  - Like What Paul Describes:

- In The Rest Of 2:8? Again "Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ!"
  - Paul's First Focus Is On:
    - What You & I May Be Captivated By!
      - And What We Need To Be On Guard For!
- We Need To "Beware" Of:
  - Christ-Less Philosophy:
    - That Can Draw Us Away From The "Simplicity That Is In Christ!" (2 Corinthians 11:3)
- What Is This "Philosophy" That Paul Is Warning Us About Here?
  - Well The Word "Philosophy" In & Of Itself:
    - Does Not Describe Something That Is Altogether Bad!
      - "Philosophy" Simply Means The Love Of & The Pursuit Of Wisdom!
        - So Not Necessarily A Bad Thing!
- But If That "Philosophy" Is Based On Things That Are Not True & Are Not Wise Then It Can Lead You Astray!
  - And Here This Is The Kind Of "False Wisdom" Paul Is Describing!
    - It Is A "Philosophy" That Is "Not After Christ!" It Is Christ-Less!
- In Fact This Is A Good Ouestion:
  - To Ask About Any Kind Of Philosophy:
    - Or Counsel Or Instruction In Your Life!
      - From Friends / Books / Blogs!
    - "Where Is Christ In This?"
  - And If Christ Cannot Be Found:
    - You Will Soon Find That Philosophy & That So-Called Wisdom To Be:
      - Faulty & Futile!
  - Which Is How Paul Describes:
    - All "Philosophy" That Is "Not After Christ!"
      - He Describes:
- Its True Substance!
  - It Is In The Words Of 2:8 "Vain Deceit!"
    - Christ-Less Philosophy & Counsel:
      - Is Like An Empty Promise!
    - IE: Like Many Of The Advertisements You Might Come Across! My Pillow! "Best Night's Sleep Ever!" Pretty Big Claim! The Wisdom Of This World Is Something That Will Always "Over-Promise & Under-Deliver!"
  - Think About The Promise:
    - Of Wealth & Riches!
      - The World's Philosophy Is The More You Have The More Content You Will Be!
        - Yet Jesus Calls It The "Deceitfulness Of Riches!"
    - It Over-Promises:
      - And Under-Delivers!
        - It Is "Vain Deceit!"
  - Think About The Promise:
    - Of Sin & Our Lusts!
      - The World's Philosophy Is Do Whatever You Want And It Will Make You Happy!
        - Yet Scripture Calls Them "Deceitful Lusts!
    - They Over-Promise:
      - And Under-Deliver!
        - They Are "Vain Deceits!"
  - Yet These Kinds Of Promises:
    - Are Used All The Time:
      - To Try To Capture & Captivate:
        - Your Mind, Your Heart, And Your Life Apart From Christ!
  - So Beware!
    - Watch Out For Anything That Might Offer You:
      - Something Wiser Or Better:
        - That Is "Not After Christ!"
          - Because It Is & Will Be Vain!

- Don't Be Captivated By What Is Empty / Vain / Futile!
  - Paul Also Describes:
- Its True Source!
  - The Reason Those "Christ-Less Philosophies" Are So Empty Is Because They Are:
    - 2:8 "After The Tradition Of Men!"
      - Now A Tradition Something That Is Passed Along From Person-To-Person:
        - Is Not Always A Bad Thing Either!
  - It Can Be Used In A Good Sense:
    - When That "Tradition" Is The Passing Down:
      - Of God's Own Truth!
        - In 2 Thessalonians 2:15 Paul Tells Us "Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle!"
  - But It Is The "Tradition Of Men" That We Need To Be Aware Of & Alert To!
    - They Are Man-Centered!
      - They Come From The Minds Of Men:
        - And Are Devoid Of Christ!
    - **IE:** One "Tradition" That We Often Hear About Is The "American Dream!" We Need To Be Careful Not To Be Captivated By This As It Can Easily Draw Us Away From The Pathway Of Christ!
  - Don't Be Captivated By What Is Futile!
    - Because Its Source Is Of Men:
      - And Not After Christ! Paul Also Describes:
- Its True Subject:
  - It Is Further 2:8 "After The Rudiments Of The World!"
    - Once Again Rudiments Something That Is A Basic Principle Or Element Of Something:
      - This Word Was Also Used To Describe The Alphabet Because Letters Are the Basic Elements Of Words!
        - And So Rudiments Are Not Always Bad Things Either!
  - It Is Used In A Good Sense:
    - In Hebrews 5:12 For The first principles of the oracles of God!"
      - We Need To Regularly Go Back To The Fundamental Truths Of God His Greatness, His Grace, His Gospel!
  - But When Those Rudiments Are:
    - "Of The World" Paul Is Describing The Fundamentals Of This Fallen World:
      - Apart From God! This Phrase Has Also Been Translated As:
        - The "Spirits Of This World!"
  - A World & A Creation:
    - That Is Opposed To Its Creator!
      - Its What Happens When God Is No Longer In Our Thoughts!
        - Life Becomes All About Chance & One's Own Choices!
  - This Is Why Evolution & Abortion & Homosexuality:
    - Have Become Such Prominent Philosophies!
      - Because They Crowd Out God & Are Contrary To His Will & His Word!
- And We Must Not Be:
  - Deluded By And Captivated By All That Is Futile!
    - Have You Been? Are You?
      - Remember "All That Glitters Is Not Gold!" So:
  - 2:8 "Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ!"
- \* But Then Won't You Be Captivated By:
- 2. What Is Full?
  - This Is What Paul Turns To Next In:
    - 2:9-10 "For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. / And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power!"
      - Here Paul's Focus Is On:
        - What You & I *Should* Be Captivated By!
          - And Can Be Captivated By!

### - It Is *Christ!*

# - It Is "In Him!"

- As We Sometimes Sing:
  - O soul, are you weary and troubled?

No light in the darkness you see?

There's light for a look at the Savior,

And life more abundant and free.

- Turn your eyes upon Jesus,

Look full in His wonderful face,

And the things of earth will grow strangely dim,

In the light of His glory and grace!

- Don't Be Captivated By:
  - Those Things That Are Futile & Empty!
    - Be Captivated By:
- The Fulness Of Christ!
  - 2:9 "For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily!"
    - There Is So Much More In Christ:
      - That Will Captivate You:
        - And Satisfy You:
          - Than This World Will Ever Have To Offer!
  - In Christ You Can See:
    - The Fulness Of Deity!
      - And What It Means To Be:
        - Fully God!
    - Need To Remember That This Is Who Jesus Is!
      - He Was & Is & Will Ever Remain God!
  - This Means That:
    - All That God Is His Nature:
      - And All That God Has His Attributes:
        - And All God Does His Actions:
          - Can Be Found In Jesus Christ Your Lord!
  - There Is No Better Philosophy:
    - And No Greater Wisdom Or Counsel:
      - Than You Can Find In Jesus Christ!
    - And This Is Why:
      - You Need To Keep Walking & Watching With Him!
    - He Is Alone Is Worthy Of:
      - All Your Love & Pursuit!
  - Because In Him Alone:
    - Will You Find What Is:
      - True & Satisfying!
        - Be Captivated By The Fulness Of Christ!
  - In Christ You Will Also See:
    - The Fulness Of Humanity!
      - And What It Means To Be:
        - Fully Man!
    - We Also Need To Remember That:
      - Jesus Became & Will Remain A Man!
  - This Means That:
    - When Jesus Was Born Into This World:
      - He Did So So That He Might:
        - Hunger & Eat With Us!
        - Thirst & Drink With Us!
        - Grieve & Weep With Us!
        - Walk & Pray With Us!
        - And Then Bleed & Die For Us!
    - As John Puts It:
      - In John 1:14 "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his

glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth!"
- And This Means That:

- In Christ You Will Find:
  - The Fulness Of God's Wisdom!
    - How Can "All The Fulness Of The Godhead" Dwell In Jesus "Bodily"?
      - How Could This "Hypostatic Union" Even Take Place?
  - Don't Know! It Remains A Mystery!
    - But It Reveals The True Wisdom Of God!
- And The Wisdom That Can Be Found:
  - In Jesus Is An Infinite Wisdom!
    - It Will Take Us All Eternity To Plumb Its Depths!
- Don't Be Captivated By:
  - Those Things That Are Trivial & Futile & Empty!
    - Be Captivated By:
      - The Fulness Of Christ!
    - And Then Be Captivated By:
- The Filling Of Christ!
  - Because 2:10 "And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power!"
    - If You Are A Christian Today:
      - And Are Walking With Him:
        - Remember That "Ye Are Complete In Him!"
  - This Means That:
    - "Possessing Him [You] Possess All!"
    - "Your Fulness Comes From His Fulness!"
    - **IE:** Its As If Jesus, An Infinite Reservoir Of The Divine Nature, Has Been Placed Within Your Own Heart! And Now Because Christ Is In Your Life All That He Is & All That He Has & All That He Does Is Available To You!
      - Calvin "There Are In Him Resources From Which We May Be Filled, That Nothing Be Wanting In Us!"
  - This Is Why Every Other:
    - Philosophy Or Wisdom Or Counsel:
      - Of This World Is So Empty & Futile!
        - Once You Have Been Filled With The Fulness Of Christ:
          - Everything Else Will Leave You Deficient!
    - **IE:** Sometimes People Have Health Problems Because There Is A "Vitamin Deficiency" And That May Be Solved By Taking Vitamin Supplements!
      - But There Is Nothing That Can Supplement Christ For The Christian!
        - Because In Christ You Have No Deficiency!
          - You Have Been Filled With All You Need! Because You Have Been Filled With The Fulness Of Jesus Christ Himself!
  - And This Can Be Seen In The Next Phrase:
    - Of 2:10 Where We Are Told That:
      - He Is "The head of all principality and power!"
        - This Seems To Have Been Something That Captivated Those Colossian Christians Back Then!
    - In 1:16 These Principalities & Powers:
      - Were Also Mentioned As Spiritual Or Angelic Beings Who They Felt Could Help Then In Their Spiritual Lives!
  - But Here Paul Reminds Them That:
    - Even Angels Were Created By Christ:
      - And Were Under The Control Of Christ!
- And So If There Is Any Attempt:
  - To Draw You Away From Christ:
    - And To Any Other Kind Of Authority Other Than Christ:
      - Remember That Jesus Is The One Who Made Them All!

#### **Conclusion:**

1. So - What Are You Captivated By This Morning?

- Is It Something In This World?
  - If So You Will Find It:
    - Empty & Vain & Futile:
      - If Christ Is Not In It!
- 2. Instead:
  - Be Captivated By:
    - The Fulness Of Christ:
      - And His Filling Of You!
  - Because:
    - If You Are A Christian:
      - "Ye Are Complete In Him!"
- 3. And He Is Worthy:
  - Of Your Attention!
    - He Is Worthy:
      - Of Your Affection!
    - He Is Worthy:
      - Of Your Captivation!
  - Remember "Possessing Him You Possess All!"
    - "Ye Are Complete In Him!"

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
