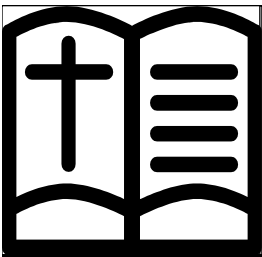

DANIEL 9:1– 11:1

PART 18: “THE SEED OF SATAN REVEALED”

I. WE WRESTLE NOT WITH FLESH AND BLOOD BUT WITH... Daniel 10:11-11:1

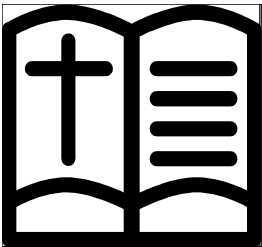
- A. *The answer to his prayer was delayed by a supernatural battle!*
 - 1. *God always hears our prayer*
 - 2. *God answers our prayers*
 - 3. *When it seems God does not answer our prayers*
 - 4. *God is good all the time and only works good for His people*
- B. *These battles go on all the time without our knowledge*
- C. *They use humans as their instruments of war to carry out their schemes*
- D. *“Babylon” is the spirit used to motivate and continue these deadly and costly wars with humans; principalities and powers*
- E. *The answer to Daniel’s prayer is the history of the world that determines the end of the time of the Gentiles!*
 - 1. *The global rule of the world has been with Gentile nations with multiple governmental forms but always with prejudice and greed*
 - 2. *The ultimate rule of the world will be a theocracy ruled by a king of Israel in Jerusalem with Israel the prominent nation*
 - 3. *It describes the final “campaign” that is known*



to us as the “tribulation” or the 70th week of Daniel

II. THE REVELATION OF THE SEED OF SATAN

- A. He first speaks of the Greek conquest by Alexander and the succeeding separation
- B. He addresses the actual history of what took place in two of those divisions of the Greek kingdom; that history mirrors the future conquest of Israel by Gentiles during the tribulation
- C. But with 11:29 the account takes a more future turn describing the one most commonly called the Antichrist
- D. Typified by Antiochus Epiphanes, the king of the north is cameoed here as the willful king who will do anything he wants 11:36 plus descriptions that do not describe Antiochus 11:36-39
- E. His conquest events, occupation of the holy land and his defilement of the sanctuary (Daniel 9:27; 11-31) are recorded from 11:29-45
- F. In chapter 12 we are told the time in which these events are occurring! And it is revealed that Michael, the great prince who stands watch over Israel, stands up to defend Israel. It is described as a time of trouble that has never been before - the great tribulation, the second half of Daniel’s 70th week Rev 12:7ff; Dan 12:7, 10; 9:27
- G. Daniel is told to shut up the words and seal up the book UNTIL the time of the end. This is the seven sealed book of Revelation that Jesus opens



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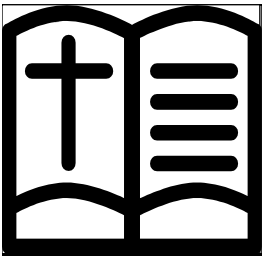
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
