## OPENING COMMENTS

© In our last Revelation related study, we touched upon The Great Olivet Discourse taught by our Lord
© I argued that out of all Scripture and apart from Revelation, Daniel's visions and this particular teaching of our Lord are the most comprehensive of all end times prophecy in both OT/NT, respectively $\mathcal{O S}_{3}$ Yes, our Lord's parables also gives us more clues, insights, into His return, the end times and the kingdom of God, but the Olivet Discourse was given to His disciples in plain language and is comprehensive
$Q_{3}$ To kick off this series, we mainly used Luke's account (Lk 21), but I also integrated Matthew's parallel account (Mt 24) so that we had a complete picture of this Great Olivet Discourse

## GOAL FOR LAST STUDY

The Goal for that study was to ascertain:

1) What our Lord meant when He said "the days will come in which there will not be left one stone upon another which will not be torn down" during this discourse
$\omega_{3}$ Hence the title of this study, "The Days will Come"
More specifically:
1. What Temple was our Lord referring to; and
2. What "sign" was our Lord referring to in His explanation to His disciples We wanted to know the answer to these 2 questions to see where the Olivet Discourse fell with respect to Daniel's visions and John's visions in the book of Revelation (beginning w/the breaking of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Seal, etc.)

## RECAP FOR $1^{\text {ST }}$ QUESTION

For the $1^{\text {st }}$ question:

1. What Temple was our Lord referring to;
cas I observed that what is widely taught and held is that our Lord was prophesying about the destruction of the $2^{\mathrm{ND}}$ Temple in 70AD by the Romans - this was teaching I was exposed to and held before we set out on this journey
$\propto \times$ Although this is a TRUE and HISTORICAL fact, this event DOES NOT fully meet what our Lord said.
as Allow me to re-show it to you

Luke 21:6 " As for these things which you are looking at, the days will come in which there will not be left one stone upon another which will not be torn down."

$Q$ "these things" in context we learned are "the temple buildings"

So Lk 21:6 can be read this way:
"As for [the temple buildings] which you are looking at, the days will come in which there will not be left one stone upon another which will not be torn down."


When we employ our ROEs (do not add or take away; literal fulfillment), when Jesus said
co "in which there will not be left one stone upon another which will not be torn down" = there will not be a single stone left upon another stone which will not be torn down"
cas So to what degree was the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Temple destroyed? What did Jewish historian Josephus tell us?


## The Wars of the Jews, Book 6

## CHAPTER 8

(403) So the Romans being now become masters of the wars, they both placed their ensigns upon the towers, and made joyful acclamations for the victory they had gained, as having found the end of this war much lighter than its beginning; for when they had gotten upon the last was, without any bloodshed, they could hardly believe what they found to be true; but seeing nobody to oppose them, they stood in doubt what such an unusual solitude could mean. (404) But when they went in numbers into the lanes of the city, with their swords drawn, they slew those whom they overtook, without mercy, and set fire to the houses wither the Jews were fled, and burnt every soul in them, and laid waste a great many of the rest; (405) and when they were come to the houses to plunder them, they found in them entire families of dead men, and the upper rooms full of dead corpses, that is of such as died by the famine; they then stood in a horror at this sight, and went out without touching anything. (406) But although they had this commiseration for such as were destroyed in that manner, yet had they not the same for those that were still alive, but they ran every one through whom they met with, and obstructed the very lanes with their dead bodies, and made the whole city run down with blood, to such a degree indeed that the fire of many of the houses was quenched with these men's blood. (407) And truly so it happened, that though the slayers left off at the evening, yet did the fire greatly prevail in the night, and as all was burning, came that eighth day of the month Gorpieus [Elul] upon Jerusalem; (408) a city that had been liable to so many miseries during the siege, that, had it always enjoyed as much happiness from its first foundation, it would certainly have been the envy of the world. Nor did it on any other account so much deserve these sore misfortunes, as by producing such a generation of men as were the occasions of this its overthrow.

## CHAPTER 9

1. (409) Now, when Titus was come into this [upper] city, he admired not only some other places of strength in it, but particularly those strong towers which the tyrants, in their mad conduct, had relinquished; (410) for when he saw their solid altitude, and the largeness of their several stones. and the exactness of their joints, as also how great was their breadth, and how extensive their length, he expressed himself after the manner following:-(411) "We have certainly had God for our assistant in this war, and it was no other than God who ejected the Jews out of these fortifications; for what could the hands of men, or any machines, do towards overthrowing these towers!" (412) At which time he had many such discourses to his friends; he also let such go free as had been bound by the tyrants, and were left in the prisons. (413) To conclude, when he entirely demolished the rest of the city, and overthrew its wars, he left these towers as a monument of his good fortune, which had proved his auxiliaries, and enabled him to take what could not otherwise have been taken by him.

## According to worldatlas.com:

The Wailing Wall is also popularly referred to as the Western Wall. It is the only remaining part of the second temple in Jerusalem's Old City. Jerusalem is claimed as the capital city of both Israel and Palestine. Presently, the wall has become a place of pilgrimage and prayer that is sacred to followers of Judaism. According to the ancient Jews, the wall was held as one of the holiest places before the Romans destroyed the city in 70 CE. The Wailing Wall has its history that can be traced back to the 2nd Century BCE, although the upper part of the wall was added much later. At present, the wall outlines part of the larger wall that surrounds the Muslim AlAqșā Mosque and the Dome of the Rock, and therefore, there is a dispute over the control or access to the wall.


## Lk 21:6

CASE IN POINT: Luke 21:6 prophesy has NOT been fulfilled yet!
Meaning any teachings that hold the view that when our Lord said, "As for these things [the temple buildings] which you are looking at, the days will come in which there will not be left one stone upon another which will not be torn down" He was prophesying of the $2^{\text {ND }}$ Temple destruction in 70AD must reconsider their position for we just proved this through Scripture and history that this is unfulfilled even to this very day!

## Lk 21:6

WE LEARNED THIS TRUTH: Instead our Lord was prophesying about yet a future temple (3 ${ }^{\text {RD }}$ Temple) that will be fully destroyed; it was that $3^{\text {RD }}$ Temple that He, Daniel, \& Paul spoke about during the end times! The $3^{\text {RD }}$ Temple is where the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION will occur and where the man of lawlessness will be revealed and display himself in that Temple proclaiming to be God!
$\infty^{\infty}$ This was a recap of our $1^{\text {st }}$ question... now a recap of our $2^{\text {nd }}$ question...

## RECAP FOR 2 ${ }^{\text {ND }}$ QUESTION

For our $2^{\text {nd }}$ question, we looked to find out:
2. What "sign" our Lord was referring to in His explanation to His disciples concerning when the temple buildings will be destroyed and what will be the sign of His coming and the end of the age are about to take place
$\propto \lll$ To answer this, I tried my best to harmonize both Lk 21 and Mt 24
$\propto_{s}$ I then tried to identify each distinct sign and event and labeled them cs SIGN \#1, SIGN \#2, SIGN \#3, etc.
\& After going through this tedious exercise, I came up with 12 distinct and unique signs and events and to keep tabs, I labeled them
or Here is the summary of them...

## THE 12 "SIGNS"

$\propto_{2}$ SIGN \#1: Many will come in My name, saying, 'I am He,' (I am the Christ) and, 'The time is near'
$\infty$ SIGN \#2: You (Israel) will hear of wars and (rumors of wars or) disturbances
$\propto_{2}$ SIGN \#3: Nation will rise against nation and kingdom against kingdom
$\alpha_{3}$ SIGN \#4: There will be great earthquakes in various places
cas SIGN \#5: There will be plagues and famines in various places
$\propto$ SIGN \#6: There will be terrors and great signs from heaven
$\infty$ SIGNS \#1-6: Are beginning of birth pangs (like contractions in labor)

## THE 12 "SIGNS"

$\sim_{3}$ SIGN \#7: You (Israel) will be delivered to tribulation, betrayed even by parents and brothers and relatives and friends and they will put some of you to death. Many will fall away and will betray one another and hate one another, and you will be hated by all nations because of My Name
Q SIGN \#8: Many false prophets will arise and will mislead many
$\propto$ SIGN \#9: Jerusalem surrounded by armies, [THE ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION will follow]
$\propto$ SIGN \#10: Many (beginning in Judea) will fall by the edge of the sword, and will be led captive into all the nations; and Jerusalem will be trampled under foot by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled - THE ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION is erected in the temple of God

## THE 12 "SIGNS"

SIGN \#11: There will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth dismay among nations, in perplexity at the roaring of the sea and the waves men fainting from fear and the expectation of the things which are coming upon the world; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken

And last but not least, the FINAL sign:
SIGN \#12: Every eye will see THE SON OF MAN COMING IN A CLOUD with power and great glory

Cos Then, what came to my mind was, coincidentally there are 12 hours in a clock
$\propto$ So to help organize these I placed each sign next to its corresponding hour and here is what we came up with originally...

## Great (Global) Tribulation

SIGN \#11: There will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth dismay among nations, in perplexity at the roaring of the sea and the waves men fainting from fear and the expectation of the things which are coming upon the world; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken

SIGN \#10: Many will fall by the edge of the sword, and will be led captive into all the nations; and Jerusalem will be trampled under foot by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled

SIGN \#9: Jerusalem surrounded by armies, THE ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION will be erected in the temple of God

SIGN \#8: Many false prophets will arise and will mislead many"

SIGN \#7: Many will fall away and will betray one another and hate one another, many will be killed and hated by all nations because of My Name

SIGNS 7-10:
Jerusalem's Tribulation

SIGN \#12: Every eye will see THE SON OF MAN COMING IN A CLOUD with power and great glory

SIGN \#1: many will come in My name, saying, 'I am He,' (I am the Christ) and, 'The time is near'

SIGN \#2: When you (Israel) hears of wars and (rumors of wars or) disturbances do not be alarmed

SIGN \#3: Nation will rise against nation and kingdom against kingdom

SIGN \#4: There will be great earthquakes in various places

SIGN \#5: There will be plagues and famines in various places

SIGN \#6: there will be terrors and great signs from heaven

## "the days will come"

So for our $2^{\text {nd }}$ question we learned "the sign" He gave His disciples concerning when the temple buildings will be fully destroyed, His return and the end of the age are about to take place, wasn't a "single" sign, but a sign consisting of at least 12 distinctive signs and events!
© TRUTH: "the sign" = the 12 SIGNS (our Lord's entire response)!
$\infty_{\infty}$ The disciples asked Him, what sign signals that the destruction of the temple, His return, and the end of the age is about to occur, and He gave them not a single sign, but a sign - comprised of at least 12 major events! Taking us to the very end of the age!
$<$ CASE IN POINT: When SIGN \#1 takes place, the prophetic clock starts ticking, followed by SIGNS \#2-12!

CB As far as where SIGN \#1 falls with respect to the breaking of the $1^{\text {ST }}$ Seal and the rider on the white horse, I initially was inclined to place them together

## UPON FURTHER REVIEW

$\infty$ As much as I would like to help make Scripture fit, I need to guard against doing that (ROEs - must take Scripture with Scripture, must not add/take away; must not take out of context; must not impose personal bias)
$\propto \&$ I need to be on a constant guard against my tendencies in straying away to alternative theories and be flexible wherever the Scripture takes us - and of course- continually cross check my work
$\propto$ So what I'd like to do from here is to examine when the prophetic clock began with SIGN \#1 (Many will come in My name, saying, 'I am He,' (I am the Christ) and, 'The time is near') in light of Scripture!

## SIGN 1: In light of Scripture

I didn't need to look too far, 1 John 2:18:
18 Children, it is the last hour; and just as you heard that antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have appeared; from this we know that it is the last hour.
$\propto \prec$ Jesus gave the Olivet Discourse in the month of Nisan AD 30
cs Day or days before our Lord was crucified
as 1John is believed to be written before Revelation, around 85-95AD
\& So about 50 years AFTER the Olivet Discourse, John said "even now many antichrists have appeared"
$\propto_{\gtrless}$ TRUTH: SIGN\#1 began BEFORE the end of the $1^{\text {st }}$ century (85-95AD)! Meaning SIGN\#1 already started BEFORE Revelation was written (95/96AD)!
$\propto$ IMPLICATION: The Rider on the White Horse is AFTER the 1st Sign!



## Revelation 6:2 <br> I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.

At this time I don't know where the $1^{\text {ST }}$ Seal falls with respect to the Great Olivet Discourse, but I came make some solid deductions.

## SIDE NOTE FROM 1JN 2: ANTICHRIST IS COMING!

## 1John 2:

18 Children, it is the last hour; and just as you heard that antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have appeared; from this we know that it is the last hour.
© In our "The Last Hour" $1^{\text {st }}$ John study, we covered this very verse cos We learned that this too was prophecy concerning the arrival of Antichrist $\propto$ So although many antichrists arrived on the scene late $1^{\text {st }}$ century (8595AD), this was also a prophetic warning that the-one-and-only Antichrist (Satan incarnate) is coming and will appear and arrive on the scene os Anyone want to venture to guess where?
$\propto$ And our Lord warned us of this in the same Olivet Discourse, and for this I'd like to cross reference Matthew's account...

## ANTICHRIST IS COMING!

Matthew 24:23-28
23 Then if anyone says to you, 'Behold, here is the Christ,' or 'There He is,' do not believe him. 24 For false Christs and false prophets will arise and will show great signs and wonders, so as to mislead, if possible, even the elect. 25 Behold, I have told you in advance. 26 So if they say to you, 'Behold, He is in the wilderness,' do not go out, or, 'Behold, He is in the inner rooms,' do not believe them. 27 For just as the lightning comes from the east and flashes even to the west, so will the coming of the Son of Man be. 28 Wherever the corpse is, there the vultures will gather.
$\propto_{2}$ Both our Lord and John warned us that the Antichrist is coming
\& Leading up to his arrival, false Christs and false prophets (both plural) will arise and will show great signs and wonders - similar to the acts of the apostles
$\sim_{P}$ When he arrives there will be an announcement of his arrival "Behold, here is the Christ" or "There he is" and when he's here he'll say "I am he" and "The time is near"-This is END TIMES PROPHECY! JESUS IS NOT COMING IN THIS WAY!

## SIGN 1: Scripture

## CASE IN POINT:

© SIGN\#1 already started way back in 85-95AD!
$\propto<$ Although the prophetic clock began late $1^{\text {st }}$ century, Antichrist himself will arrive on the scene towards the end of the age
$\propto \times$ When Antichrist arrives - that's when the destruction of the $3^{\text {RD }}$ Temple, Jesus's return, and the end of the age our Lord spoke of is AT HAND!
$\propto \ll$ That's what Scripture tells us in light of SIGN \#1 (Many will come in My name, saying, 'I am He,' (I am the Christ) and, 'The time is near')
© R Next, I'd like to look at SIGNS \#1-6 (Birth Pangs) in light of history since they are POST-Revelation...
© Again here are SIGNS \#1-6...
