Q1. WHY DOES GOD “WAIT”?

- A. WE MUST MEET HIS CONDITIONS
- B. HIS JUSTICE MUST BE UPHELD

- A. OUR GOOD
- B. HIS GLORY

Q3. WHY DO WE NEED GRACE & MERCY?

- A. ‘DIRECT JUSTICE’ WILL NOT SAVE US
- B. GOD HAS MADE A COVENANT WITH HIS PEOPLE (“SONS”)

Q4. WHAT SHALL WE DO, THEN?

- A. REPENT TURN, 30:15; CRY, 30:19; TURN, 31:6–7
- B. BELIEVE (~30:12); REST/TRUST 30:15; WAIT 30:18
- C. AND BEAR FRUIT 30:19–22, 29
