

RELIGIOUS PEOPLE NEED THE GOSPEL Acts 13:13-43

God is good all the time – Truly His mercy endures forever!

Paul received a gracious **invitation** to preach (v.13-15).

God was gracious in the **past** (v.16-25).

God was gracious by **keeping His promise** (v.26-37)

God promised a **Savior** and He has come (v.26).

They were hearing **sermons**, but they were missing the **Savior** (v.27).

All was fulfilled concerning Jesus – **the gospel** (v.28-37).

God will be gracious **to you** (v.38-41). The final point is the point of application and invitation.

They were preaching **forgiveness** for sins.

They were preaching a **right relationship** with God (justification).

They were preaching salvation by **grace** through **faith**. Only believe!

They were preaching with **powerful incentive**.

Paul received **mixed response** to the preaching (v.42-43).

Some walked away **indifferent**.

Some begged **for more** to be taught them.

Some believed and **followed** Paul and Barnabas (Gal 1.6-9).

A serious warning to religious people:

Are you in the church but outside of Christ? Do you regularly hear the sermons but have yet to respond to the message? There is no special category for religious sympathizers. Have you believed?
