

- Can you put a real face to such categories of sin?




There could hardly have been a more notorious, dark-hearted, and hopeless sinner, in the minds of most the Jewish people in Jesus day, than tax collectors.

# #2: Jesus Calls All Sinners to Fellowship with Him (Mark 2:15-16)


- The word “sinners” (Mark 2:16) used here refers to people of bad reputation in the community, people well known as sinners - other tax collectors, prostitutes, adulterers, social outcasts.

# The Escalation of the Religious Leader's Hatred of Jesus

- *Mark 2:6* - The religious leaders simply thought accusing thoughts about Jesus
- *Mark 2:16* - The religious leaders now speak out and vocalize their disgust, but do so only to Jesus' disciples
- *Mark 2:24* - The religious leaders will vocalize their disgust directly to Jesus
- *Mark 3:6* - The religious leaders are plotting to kill Jesus

# #2: Jesus Calls All Sinners to Fellowship with Him (Mark 2:15-16)

- If we would be like Jesus in this regard we must be with those who do not know Jesus (John 17:15)


# #3: Jesus Calls All Sinners to Flee from their Sin (Mark 2:17)
