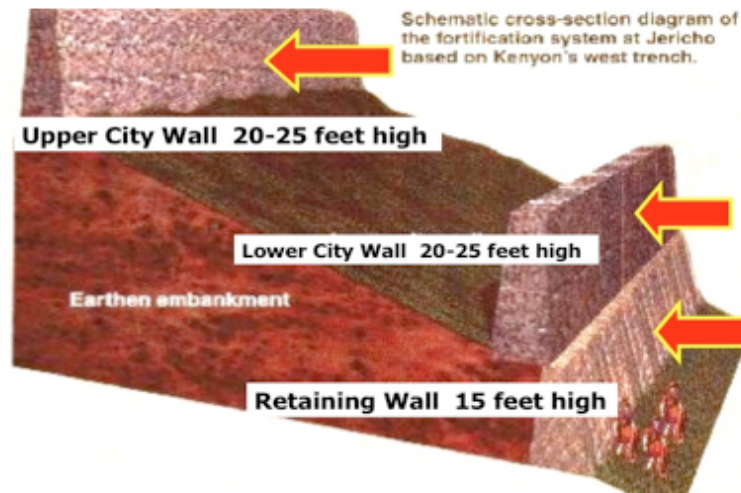
Bottom Line:
