- 1. What wld you say to a congregation about to be invaded? Isa 33:5-6
- 2. <u>Hab</u> familiar but relevant

1st: Habakkuk Encourages Us To Keep An Eschatological Perspective

- 1. Perspective on ethics: 2 perplexing questions will be resolved in future
 - i. 1st: *why* 1:3-4 & v14
 - ii. 2nd: how long? 1:2 Hab 2:3
 - iii. A perspective on history that transcends history. 2:20 silent serenity.
- 2. Perspective on hope. 2:14. Satan's ploy = truncated hope. Rv 21:1-5
- **3.** Perspective on authority: <u>2:20</u>. Can issues of conscience be adjudicated in men's courts or God's court? Isa 5:20. Chpt 2 prophetic *woes*.

2nd: Habakkuk Encourages Us To Persevere in Hearing God's Word

- 1. We serve exalted Lord by proclaiming His Word 2:2-3.
- **2.** So many speakers!! [Jer 23:29] Be silent before enthroned Lord. He Speaks *This is My Beloved Son: Hear Him* Hb 12:25

3rd: Habakkuk Encourages Us To Persevere In Prayer

- 1. 3:1-2 Hab stops arguing & submits O Lord
 - i. I have heard
 - ii. the report
 - iii. and I fear
 - iV. the report about $You \Rightarrow Your work 1:5$
 - V. Shigionoth = highly emotional hymn
- 2. Hab lives in midst of the yrs (2x) the day of distress (3:16). Time tw/2 acts of judgment: on Judah & on Bab: time = in wrath. We live tw/2 acts of judgment: cross & 2nd coming/Final Judgment [Rm 1:17-18]. Pray.
 - i. Petition #1: Revive Your work in & for us

- ii. Petition #2: Reveal understanding: give discernment
- iii. Petition #3: Remember to be merciful: Ex 34:6-7. [Isa 49:15]

4th: Habakkuk Encourages Us To Persevere By Faith

- 1. <u>2:4b</u> Faith of Abraham *the righteous by faith shall live* [Gal & Rm]; *the righteous shall live by faith* [Heb 10:35-39].
- 2. Victory of Warrior God: apocalyptic 3:3-15 Perseverance of Saints

5th: Habakkuk Encourages Us To Persevere In Priestly Worship

- 1. I have heard the report about You & I fear 3:16-19 in fear & trembling yet I will exult in the Lord He strengthens me to walk on my high places
- 2. Worship & warfare. 3:16 *I must wait quietly to rest.* 1] Submission; 2] Security; 3] Sabbath Keeping; 4] Sacrificial worship *soothing aroma beside quiet waters* [Ps 23:2] table spread in presence of enemies.
- 3. <u>3:19b</u> 3:3-15 sung in worship celebrate: [Isa 38:20]
- 4. Septuagint v19: The Lord God is my strength & He has made my feet like hinds' feet, & brings me to completion on my high places that I may conquer in His song. [Rm 8:37] conquer. We conquer in His song.
- **5**. Really? <u>2Chron 20:1-30</u>
- **6.** Do you believe that the Lord defends His worshiping people? I ask "Do you believe?" b/c the *righteous man will live by faith.*
- 7. How? *wait quietly*: worship & sing; read & run; live by faith not by fear. Christ is with us. Christ is coming for us. Persevere the righteous shall live & conquer by faith. AMEN
