

“I am the Door”

(The Parable of the Sheepfold)
John 10:1-10



Introduction:

I. The Illustration of the Sheepfold (v.1-6)

- A. The Sheep enter only one door (v.1-3)
- B. The Sheep heed only one voice (v.4-6)

II. The Interpretation of the Sheepfold Parable (v.7-8)

- A. Jesus is the only door the sheep enter (v.7)
- B. Jesus is the only voice the sheep heed (v.8)

III. The Invitation to enter the sheepfold (v.9-10)

- A. He is the exclusive entryway (v.9a)
(He is a door that is exclusive)
- B. He is an open entryway (v.9b)
(He is a door that is open)
- C. He is a safe entryway (v.9c-10a)
(He is a door that leads to safety)
- D. He is a satisfying entryway (v.10b)
(He is a door that leads to satisfaction)
