1 Samuel 18:1-9

I. God uses different kinds of people in our lives

- a. Good people – 18:1-4, 20:17, 23:16 - Jonathan
- b. Not so good people – 18:5-9 – Saul
 - i. Jealousy – 18:9, 12, 14-29

II. Handling people God’s way

- a. Focus on MY actions not my enemy – 18:5, 14, 19:1-9 (Ephesians 4:26-27)
- b. Do right in all situations – 20:1, 8, 24:11, 26:17-18, 23-25
- c. Remember, God is in control & has a purpose
 - i. God’s direction – 20:32-42
 - ii. Ministry opportunities – 22:1-2
 - iii. God’s power – 18:12, 14, 23:14
- d. Let God deal with wrong doing – 24:1-13 (Chapter 26), Romans 12:9-21
