Sermon Series: Romans

Sermon Text: Romans 8:5-8 The Life of the Mind

The Spiritual life is produced and energized by the Spiritual mind which is formed by Spiritual existence.

1) The Holy Spirit gives Christ's people a Godward existence (8:5a).

- a) "those who live according to the flesh/Spirit" is literally "those who are of the flesh/Spirit" indicating contrasting states of being, existence, and "basic moral condition" (Murray)
 - i) flesh=corrupt and unredeemed human nature
 - ii) Spirit=Holy Spirit
- b) Application:
 - i) Christianity is not merely a way of life, it is a Godward existence.
 - ii) Regeneration/New Creation

2) The Holy Spirit produces a Godward mind in Christ's people (8:5-8).

- a) The Greek term for mind (phrēn) is broader than intellect, including the affections and will.
- b) The mind of flesh *is* death: "hostile to God"; "does not submit to God's law"; "cannot submit to God's law"; "cannot please God"
- c) The mind of the Spirit is life and peace: alive to God, at peace with God, peaceful, peace-making
- d) Application:
 - i) "Contrary to what seems to be quite generally supposed, thinking cannot be avoided by the Christian man" (J. Gresham Machen, What Is Faith?, 242).
 - ii) God gave us His Word.
 - iii) Psalms, hymns, and Spiritual songs (Eph. 5:18-19; Col. 3:16).
 - iv) Pastors and Teachers
 - v) Spiritual Knowledge is:
 - (1) loving God
 - (2) humble to learn and grow
 - (3) peace
