The Seventy Weeks And after the sixty-two weeks—final week, lower resolution (v. 26) An anointed one cut off, stripped of everything A mighty and numerous people shall destroy Jerusalem and the sanctuary (again) Final week—higher resolution (vs. 27) The anointed one confirms a covenant with many and puts an end to sacrifice and offering (i.e., the entire sacrificial system) The "wing" abominations will coincide with the eventual desolation of Jerusalem and the sanctuary (again) Singing Zion's Songs in a Foreign Land Along obedience in the same direction
