- B. Two things
 - 1. Burial is for the dead, the Roman Soldiers knew that He was dead
 - 2. The Gospels tell of Joseph of Arimathea receiving the Body of Jesus to put in his grave fulfilling Isaiah 53:9 Mt 27:57-60; Mk 15:42-46; Lk 23:50-56; Jo 19:38-42

VII "Rose From the Grave" - Part 1 - "According to the Scripture"

- A. The Doctrine of the Resurrection
 - 1. *anastasis* a standing up again, a resurrection from death, raised to life again, resurrection, rise from the dead, that should rise, rising again.
 - a. used 43 times
 - b. used 3 times w/ pronoun prefix out of or from
 - 2. Used referring to two separate resurrection
 - a. the resurrection of Christ
 - b. The resurrection of humanity includes both saved and unsaved

 - 2. OT predictions repeated in the NT

 - e. Marys go to tell the disciples and meet Jesus Mt 28:8-10;
 - f. Marys tell the disciples Mk 16:8; Lk 24:9-10; Jo 20:2,18
 - g. Disciple reaction and go to the grave Mk 16:11; Lk 24:11-12; Jo 20:3-10
 - h. Soldiers and religious leaders devise lie of stolen body Mt 28:11-15
 - 5. Evidences
 - i. Ac 1:3 to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

- ii. 1 Co 15:5 He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve
- iii. 1Co 15:6 After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep.
- iv. Ac 10:41 "not to all the people, but to witnesses chosen before by God, even to us who ate and drank with Him after He arose from the dead.
