Jesus Said 16 A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father.

17 Then said some of his disciples among themselves, What is this that he saith unto us, A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me: and, Because I go to the Father?

18 They said therefore, What is this that he saith, A little while? we cannot tell what he saith.

19 Now Jesus knew that they were desirous to ask him, and said unto them, Do ye enquire among yourselves of that I said, A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me?

20 Verily, verily, I say unto you, That ye shall weep and lament, but the world shall rejoice: and ye shall be sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into joy.

21 A woman when she is in travail hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, she remembereth no more the anguish, for joy that a man is born into the world.

22 And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you.

23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.

24 Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

25 These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly of the Father.

26 At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you:

of the New Testament: (1) He expressly declared things unrevealed (v. 12). (2) He promised that all things would be revealed to the Spirit should come, and should include new prophecies (v. 13). (3) He included additional revelations, and to be His witnesses (v. 16, 13; Acts 1, 8; 9, 15-17). LORD'S PRAYER CHAPTER 17. **PRAYER**
 The prayer of intercession.

THESE words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee: (Reciprocal)

2 As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou wilt: 18:9

3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent: ~~As for one among man~~

4 I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.

5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the Father.

1 Seven petitions: (1) That Jesus may be glorified with the Father (v. 1; Phil. 2, 9-11); (2) for restoration of the safety of believers from (a) the world (v. 15) and (b) the sanctification of believers (v. 17); (5) for the safety of the world (v. 21); (7) that they may behold and share His glory (v. 24).

2 Christ's gifts to those whom the Father has given to Him (v. 17); the Father's name (vs. 6, 26; Joh 20: 17); the Father's glory (v. 22).

3 Seven times Jesus speaks of believers and their safety (v. 9, 11, 12, 24). Jesus Christ is God and believers are the Father's love-gift to the world (v. 16); the Father's love-gift to the world (v. 16); the Father's faithfulness to His Son Jesus Christ (v. 19).
