071121A INTRODUCTION

- 1. Paul "missionary theologian" [Robert Reymond] A 13:15-25 "The Coming of the Davidic King" who? v23 a Savior, Jesus.
- 2. When did the Davidic King come? JnB. Now, 2nd section of sermon: Jesus' life, death & res interp'd by OT prophecy & proclaimed by King's Apostle.

1st: The Good News of the Resurrected Davidic King - [v26-32a]

- 1. v26: ethnic Jews & God-fearers brethren [description for NCov church]: to us. Recipients of message of salvation has been sent [root "apostle"]. Who sent this message? God!
- 2. v27-29 death of *Him* who? <u>v23</u> Savior = Jesus David's heir to throne
 - i. v27-28 injustice by Sanhedrin & Pilate
 - ii. Irony Sanhed: by breaking God's law, they fulfilled OT prophecy.
 - iii. Emph on fulfillment of Script in v27 & 28.
 - iv. What is message of this salvation [v26]? OT + apostolic witness to death & res of Jesus proclaimed & interp'd according to Scripture w/ a summons to repent & believe [v38ff].
- 3. <u>v30</u> But God THE Actor in Redemptive History is GOD
 - i. raised Him from the dead [v22 raised up David]. Overturned unjust verdicts; overcame power of death to res life of age to come.
 - ii. v31 post-res appearances to apostles = *witnesses to the people* [Israel]
- 4. <u>v32a</u> now we [Paul includes himself] preach the good news = 1 word: "gospeling" to you!
- 5. How did Paul know of Jesus' life & death?
 - i. apostolic tradition oral equivalent to written Scripture. 2Th 2:15; 3:6
 - ii. 1C 11:23 [LT] received & delivered = technical vocab 1C 15:3-5
 - iii. Paul cld've received apostolic trad while in Jerusalem & met apostles.

Applic #1: The Gospel Consists of Biblical Facts Concerning Jesus

- 1. The gospels extended introductions to the death & resurrection of Jesus
- 2. Paul presents hist'al facts; events that occurred some 15yrs ago.
 - i. $\underline{v30}$ But God raised Him from the dead = hist'al fact.
 - ii. Select men = *witnesses*. Their witness is also an hist'al fact.
 - iii. The preaching of the gospel is a fact of history explained by the resurrection of Jesus.
- 3. We are responsible to communicate the facts of the gospel as history [not myth, dreams, visions].

2nd: The Good News of the Fulfillment of Promises About the Resurrected King [32b-37]

- 1. The *salvation* = fulfillment of *the promise* made to *fathers:* but God made many promises in OT covenants, yet Paul speaks of a singular *promise* = the resurrection of Jesus. v34 [*blessings* = *mercies* in Isa 55:3] Resurrection of Jesus is the essence of all promises [2C 1:20a]
 - i. to our children [cf NASB, ASV, NAS] or [KJV, NKV, NIV, ESV]: to us their children to us [v26]: Who? [v16, v26, v32, v38]
 - ii. To all who receive the message that *the promise* is fulfilled in Jesus.

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- 2. Paul interps Jesus' death & res 3 Script'al prophesies
 - i. v33 = **Ps 2:7** *begotten* : coronation of Son: inheritance of nations.
 - ii. v34 = Isa 55:3 [Mat 1:1]. The King & His kingdom: based on res.
 - iii. v34-35 **Ps 16** not *decay* [2x]: bodily resurrection [v36-37] [A2:29-32]
- 3. <u>A 9:20,22</u> proclaiming = heralding, announcing, declaring w/ authority
 - i. *proving* compiling texts from OT
 - ii. confounding putting texts together in a way that was unfamiliar but used the Bible to interpret the Bible.
 - iii. In A13:33-35 [NT] cites Ps 2:7; Isa 55:3 & Ps 16.

Applic #2: The Gospel Consists of Biblical Interpretation of Jesus

- 1. v34 the <u>fact</u> history interpreted by Scripture: He has spoken Hb 1:1-2
- 2. How shld we understand Jesus' "passion"? v27-29. Ignorant of Script & the arrival of the promised Savior. Unconverted religionists *condemned & put Him to death* unwittingly fulfilling *all that was written about Him.* God makes Evil itself subservient to His saving purpose.
- 3. What does Jesus' life, death & res mean? <u>A13:35-37</u> Jesus is the Res'd Davidic King. Beware interps of unconverted religionists! *He has spoken! He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.*
- 4. Let us hear w/ faith & explain Jesus faithfully according to Scripture.
