QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. Where is the church continuing to meet? And what is Jesus doing through the apostles?
2. How does the old covenant leadership respond to Jesus' saving presence in v. 17?
3. What happens in the middle of the night while the apostles are in prison? What does it lead to?
4. How do the apostles respond to the threats of the Jewish leaders, commanding them not to speak of Christ? See v. 29 and vv. 41-42.
5. How are the old covenant leaders different than the new covenant leaders? What is the main difference? And how does this apply to us today?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. How does zeal for Christ relate to the fear of Christ? How might I grow in the fear of God so that I am dying to the fear of man?
2. Do I view suffering for Christ as a dreaded possibility or a joyous privilege?
3. How could I be praying for my elders more consistently and biblically? What are the chief things I should pray for them?
