## I. Peter's Prop

A. Peter's prop: the man who was healed standing with them (Acts 4:13)

- 1. His former condition pictures all of us unsaved
  - a. You are impotent (spiritually paralyzed)
  - b. You are hopeless humanly speaking
  - c. You are banished from communion with God
- 2. His present conditions pictures all of us saved by God's grace
  - a. Acts 4:10 pictures the born-again soul (2 Cor. 5:17)
  - b. Acts 3:8 pictures the restored communion with God
  - c. Acts 3:16 pictures the future of every believer in Christ
- B. How did all this happen?
  - 1. Peter points away from himself to Jesus (Acts 3:16; 4:10; Eph. 2:8)

## II. Peter's Text

- A. Peter declared the Name of Jesus as only Name
  - 1. Jesus is His personal name chosen by His Father
  - 2. Jesus' name is the revelation of His purpose (Matt. 1:21; Cat. Q. 29)

- B. Peter's sermon then is God's message today
  - 1. Who or whatever you are, you are directed to look to Jesus
    - a. do not go to anyone else (Is. 43:11)
    - b. do not seek it in other people, no matter how saintly (Ps. 49:7-8)
    - c. do not try to be saintly in order to be saved (Cat. Q. 30)

Close: Your salvation from *guilt & power of sin* is in Almighty Savior! A. Have you accepted the truth of your condition?

- B. Let the dismal truth of yourself not cause you to despair of Jesus' truth
  - 1. He is a complete Savior
    - a. in Him is everything necessary to be saved
    - b. with Him you are welcome
    - c. with Him you are secure
  - 2. Have you received this Savior?
