1 Seven petitions: (1) That Jesus may be glorified by the Father (v. 1; Phil. 2. 9-11); (2) for restoration of the safety of believers from (a) the world (v. 11) and (b) the sanctification of believers (v. 17); (5) for the safety of the world (v. 21); (7) that believers may behold and share His glory (v. 24).

2 Christ's gifts to those whom the Father gave to Him: the Father's name (vs. 6, 26; John 20. 17); the Father's glory (v. 13); His own glory (v. 22).

3 Seven times Jesus speaks of believers as given to the Father [twice], 9, 11, 12, 24). Jesus Christ is God's love-gift to the Father and believers are the Father's love-gift to Jesus Christ. the believer to the Father for safe-keeping, so that the Father's faithfulness to His Son Jesus Christ.

- (vs 1) Glorify God
(vs 3) Life eternal - know God
(vs 4) Finished the work
(vs 6) Manifest God's Name
(vs 7) all things "of thee"
