The Parable of the Unjust Steward (Luke 16:1-13)

- 1. The Parable—A steward is responsible for managing the master's resources (16:1-8a).
- 2. The First Lesson—Steward that which God has given you with intentionality, that is, with divine purpose (16:8b-9).
- 3. The Second Lesson—Steward that which God has given you with integrity, that is, with unwavering faithfulness (16:10-12).
- 4. The Third Lesson—Steward that which God has given you with intensity, that is, with undivided loyalty (16:13).
