Questions to ask yourself about your faith:

- 1) Was there a time when I honestly realized that I was a sinner and I admitted that to myself and to God?
- 2) Do I truly believe that Christ died for my sins and arose again to fulfill the prophecy of God’s Son, the true Risen Savior?
- 3) Have I trusted in Christ alone for my salvation and has there been a noticeable change in my life since I exercised my faith in Him?
- 4) Do I secretly love sin or do I desire to turn away from it?
- 5) Do I have a desire to glorify Christ in my life and share Him with others?
