	believer generally in various aspects of life – in the family, in the church, in the world {Titus 2}.						
3.	This passage shifts from contending for (1:9, 13) to encouraging true						
	godliness reflected in (2:1, 2:8) which is manifested in						
	(1:1, 16; 2:7, 2:14; 3:5, 8, 14)						
4.	This passage addresses within the local churches – OLDER MEN						
	(2:2), OLDER WOMEN (2:3), YOUNG WOMEN (2:4-5), YOUNG MEN (2:6-8), and						
	BONDSERVANTS as God has a plan & design for every child of God. (2:9-10)						
5.	This passage gives 3 important purposes for these practical instructions:						
	a. "that the word of God may not be blasphemed." (2:5)						
	b. "that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you." (2:8)						
	c. "that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things."(2:10)						
6.	. This passage underscores the basis and means of accomplishing all this, namely the
