## 2 Timothy 2:8–13 (NKJV)

8 Remember that Jesus Christ, of the seed of David, was raised from the dead according to my gospel,

9 for which I suffer trouble as an evildoer, even to the point of chains; but the word of God is not chained.

**23** For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror;

**24** for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.



# I. Remember the Resurrection of Jesus Christ (v. 8)


8 Remember that Jesus Christ, of the seed of David, was raised from the dead according to my gospel,



## 1 Timothy 3:1 (NKJV)

1 This is a **faithful saying**: If a man desires the position of a bishop, he desires a good work.





## 1 Timothy 4:7–9 (NKJV)

7 But reject profane and old wives' fables, and exercise yourself toward godliness.

8 For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come.
